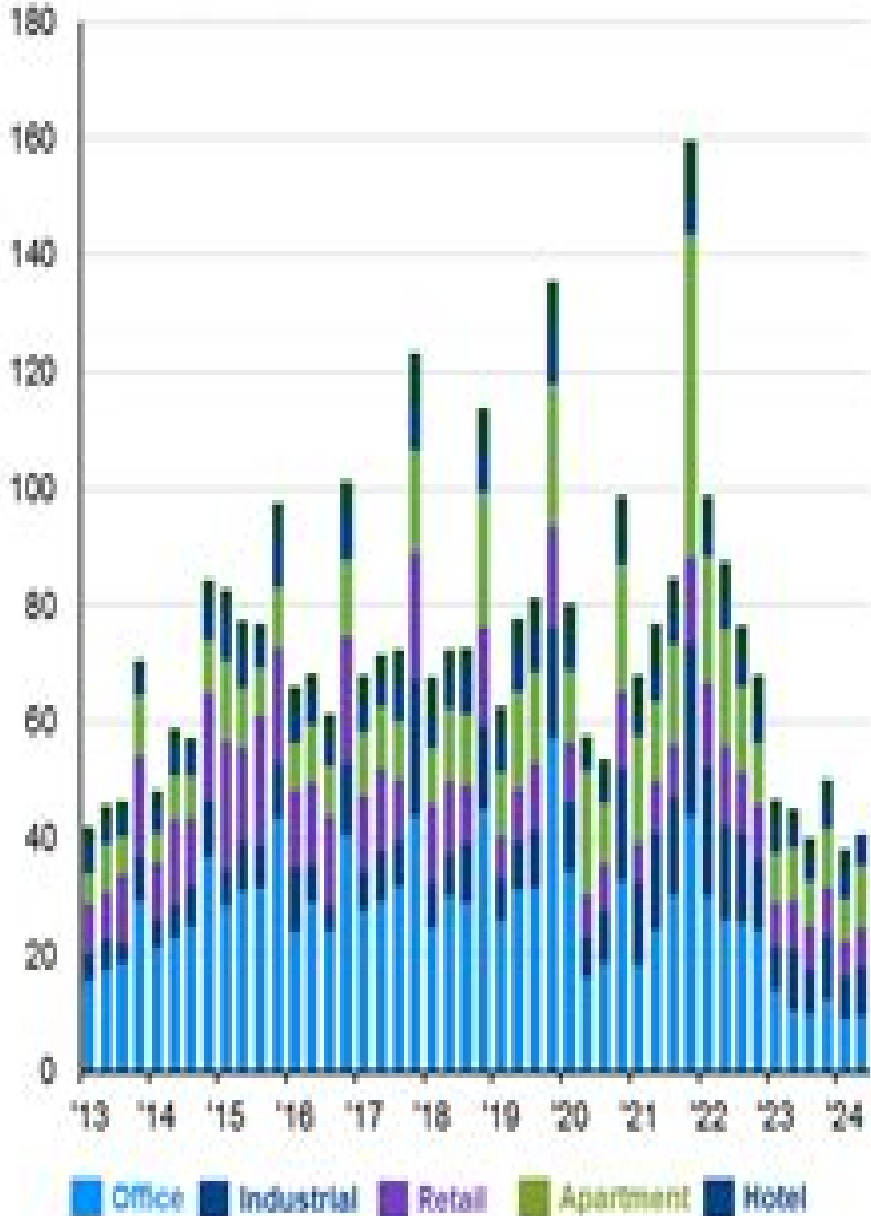
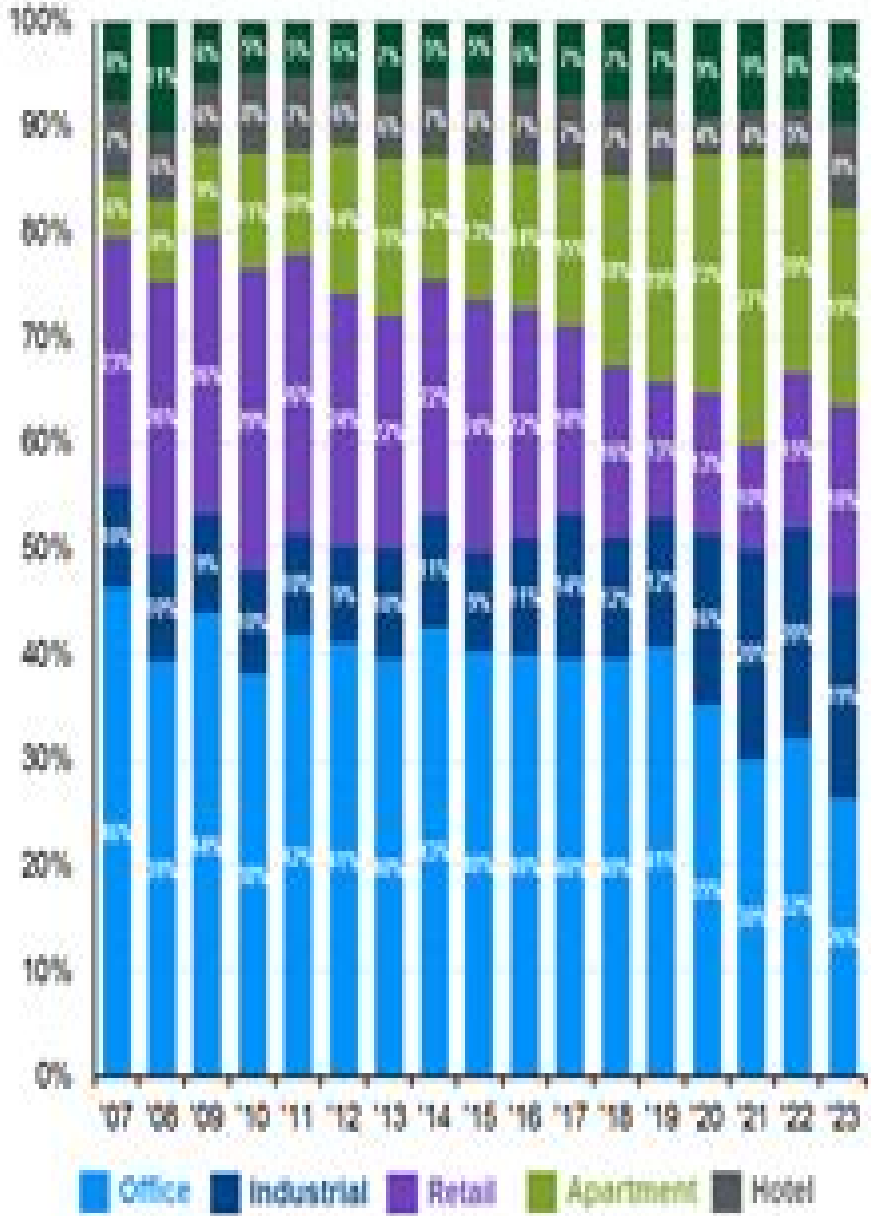


European transaction volumes
