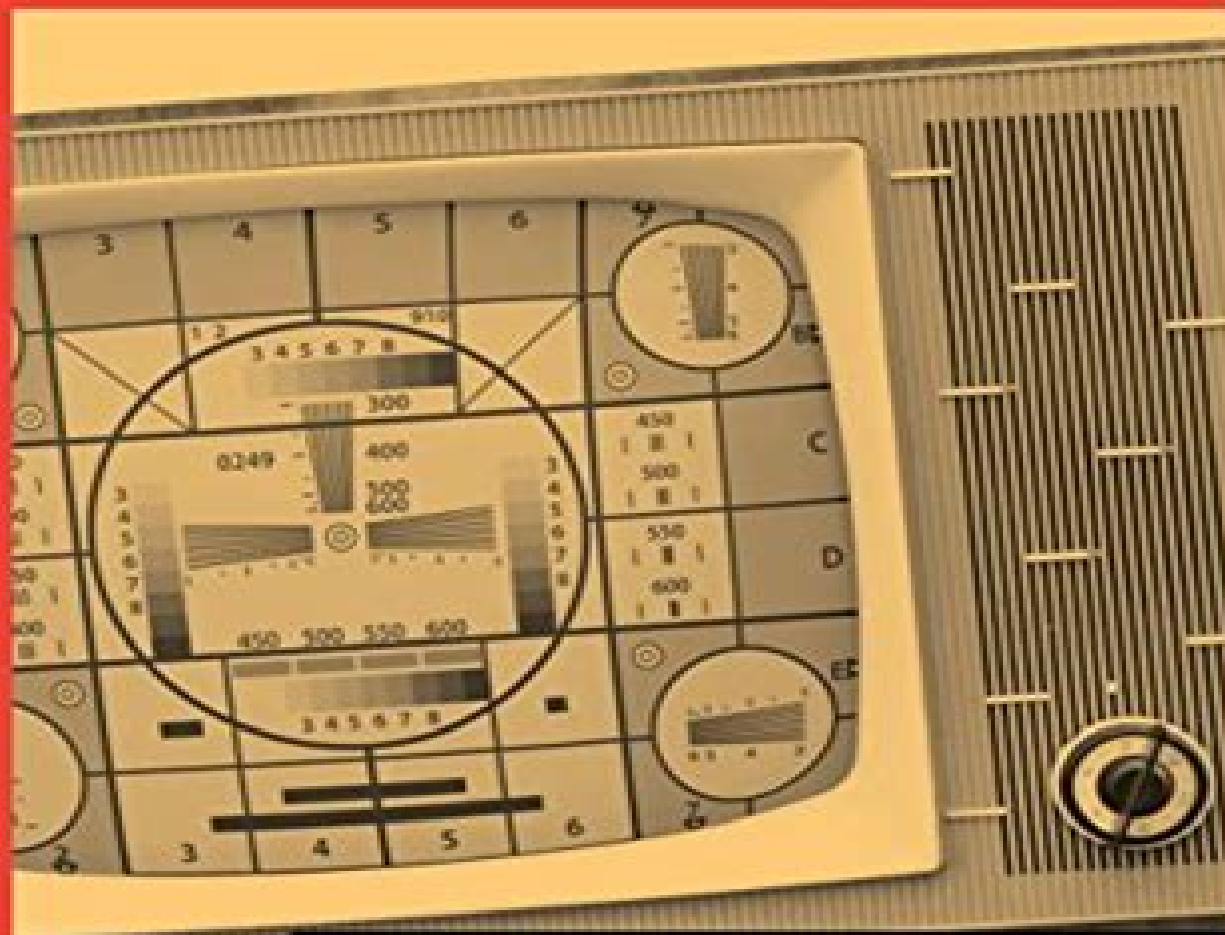

Embodying Xuanzang Benjamin Brose, 2023 Xuanzang 600 602 664 was one of the most accomplished and consequential monks in the history of East Asian Buddhism Celebrated for his sixteen year pilgrimage from China to India his transmission and translation of hundreds of Buddhist texts and his training of a generation of masters in China Korea and Japan Xuanzang's life and legacy are the stuff of legend In the centuries after his death stories of his epic adventures and extraordinary accomplishments circulated in texts images songs and plays These mythic accounts recast the erudite pilgrim translator and court cleric as a magical monk who traveled not between China and India but between heaven and earth Beset by bloodthirsty demons this deified version of Xuanzang navigates the perilous paths of the netherworld to reach a pure land in the west His purpose is to

Nnolim, 2010 This Third Edition of *Approaches to the African Novel* is a child of necessity Because of the unfortunate death of the publisher of Saros International who issued the First Edition and high demand this third enlarged edition has become imperative Three new essays all previously published are added two expectedly on Achebe the father of the African novel and one on Mongop Beti's Mission to Kala which was partially anthologised in *Contemporary Literary Criticism* Volume 27 1984 Achebe's *Things Fall Apart* as an Igbo national epic has evoked a spate of reactions from critics of African literature especially the troika

Chinweizu et al in *Toward the Decolonization of African Literature* It was also anthologised in *Modern Black Literature* edited by S Okechukwu Menu 1971 The essay on Arrow of God whose structure and meaning has been largely avoided by other critics is included here for further airing For gender balance as the previous volume contained no essays on women writers an essay on Flora Nwapa has been added Since the novels discussed in this volume exclusively are on the African literature south of the Sahara the last essay on Peter Abrahams comes in to round out this collection of essays with a study of a south African writer for geographical balance

The Prose Literature of the Gaelic Revival, 1881-1921 Philip O'Leary, 2011-12-31 The Gaelic Revival has long fascinated scholars of political history nationalism literature and theater history yet studies of the period have neglected a significant dimension of Ireland's evolution into nationhood the cultural crusades mounted by those who believed in the centrality of the Irish language to the emergent Irish state This book attempts to remedy that deficiency and to present the lively debates within the language movement in their full complexity citing documents such as editorials columns speeches letters and literary works that were influential at the time but all too often were published only in Irish or were difficult to access Cautiously employing the terms nativist and progressive for the turnings inward and toward the European continent manifested in different authors this study examines the strengths and weaknesses of contrasting positions on the major issues confronting the language movement Moving from the early collecting or retelling of folklore through the search for heroes in early Irish history to the reworking of ancient Irish literary materials by retelling it in modern vernacular Irish O'Leary addresses the many debates and questions concerning Irish writing of the period His study is a model for inquiries into the kind of linguistic literary movement that arises during intense nationalism

The Place of the Gospels in the General History of Literature Karl Ludwig Schmidt, 2020-09-18 Karl Ludwig Schmidt's classic *Die Stellung der Evangelien der allgemeinen Literaturgeschichte* was one of a handful of twentieth century essays on the New Testament to set the agenda for an entire generation of New Testament scholars First published in 1923 the text laid out Schmidt's contention that the gospels represent a literary genre that does not derive from others in the ancient world In portraying the gospels as the written record of an oral tradition rather than as biographical or historical text the German scholar found points of comparison with Sayings of the Desert Fathers and the later collections of Faust legends Schmidt's powerful argument has commanded attention in Germany for decades but has never before been fully available in English In recent years the question of gospel genre has reemerged as an issue of debate With this translation Byron R McCane enables a new generation of English speaking scholars to engage with Schmidt's classic perspective on an enduring question In an introduction to the volume John Riches places Schmidt's landmark study in its context He locates the text among the writings of the form critics with whom Schmidt allied himself and relates it to Schmidt's own still untranslated study of the topography and chronology of the gospels He documents the essay's reception in the English speaking world and critically

examines the way Schmidt is understood in present day discussion of the genre of the gospels Riches also explores how recent efforts to classify the gospels as ancient biographies have in many ways misread and misrepresented Schmidt s views errors that this translation will help rectify
