

- RESOURCE TYPES Labor, Land, Capital & Enterpreneurship: Any or all of which are used by a company to produce its output.
- MARGINAL REVENUE PRODUCT (MIRPS The marginal revenue obtained from the marginal unit employed. MRP FORMULA: MR × MP (marginal revenue > marginal product).
- MARGINAL FACTOR COST (MFC): The marriant cost of the last unit employed.
- COMPANIES WILL EMPLOY UNITS OF A RESOURCE (i.e. man hours; pounds of a move material; machine hours) until the marginal revenue obtained from the increased production generated by the marginal unit equals the marginal cost of that unit (MRP - MFC).

- MRP CURVE is the firm's demond curve for the firm's combined factors of production, where the marginal products per dollar spent are the same for each factor: MP, MP, where w is the wage nate and r is the rental cost of capital.
- MONOPSONY: Monopoly in the Resource Market is called Monopsony. The monopsonist will hire the factor (L) where MRP = MFC_{NN}, which is less than in perfect competition, and pay wape (W_{Mh}) lower than in perfect competition (W_{PC}). The monopsonist will pay the minimum wage labor is willing to accept.









EXTERNALITIES

- *DEFINITION: Benefits received or costs imposed on others as a result of an economic activity to which they are not a party. Such activity can involve production or consumption.
- EX: Environmental pollution involves a negative externality. Pollution abatement involves a positive externality.
- SOCIALLY OPTIMAL LEVEL OF PRODUCTION OR CONSUMPTION: Occurs when marginal social benefits equal marginal social costs.
- COASE THEOREM: In a system where legal damages can be collected from a person or from a negative externality, the private market system will produce at the socially optimal level, provided property rights are well-defined and costs of regotiations are low-

- PUBLIC POLICY approaches to the problem of externalities include:
- 1. Regulations limiting activities with negative externalities or requiring minimal levels of activities that have positive externalities.
- 2. Taxes on activities that have negative externalities and subsidies on activities with positive externalities.
- 3. Sales of licenses that, in aggregate, permit socially optimal levels of the negative externality. Allowing these licenses to be traded provides firms with the incentives to reduce the amount of the negative externality they produce.
- PUBLIC GOODS: Goods that are non-excludable and non-rival.
- 1. Consuming public goods does not remove availability to other
- 2. Consuming public goods does not exclude other consumers from enjoying the same benefits. It would be impossible or impractical to do so.
- 3. Each individual's consumption leads to no subtraction from any other individual's consumption of that good.
- 4. Does not have the free-rider problem in private goods (assuming envery/heady pages him/her taxons).

- MERIT GOODS: Goods identified in society to possess social benefits beyond private demand for them.
 - 1. Individual choice is restrained by companity values.
