

THE DIGESTIVE SYSTEM

- The job of the digestive system is to break down large food molecules. This is called digestion. Digestion happens in two ways: physical and chemical.
- The digestive process is as follows:
 1. Chemical Digestion starts in the mouth through enzymes and saliva. The food is then moved to the stomach.
 2. The Small Intestine receives the food next and produces protease and lipase, food is absorbed into blood, large surface area by villi.
 3. Large Intestine (Colon) is where indigestible food is passed to. Any excess water is absorbed before it is excreted from the anus.

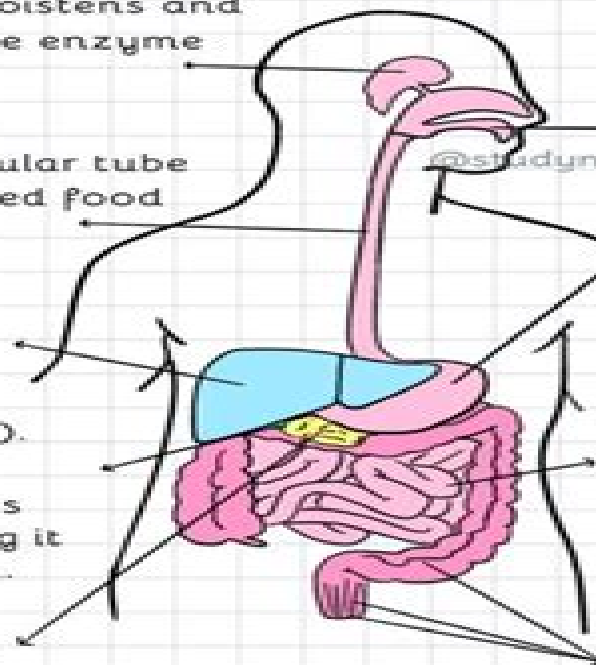
Salivary glands- moistens and lubricates food. The enzyme amylase digests carbohydrates.

Oesophagus- muscular tube which moves ingested food in the stomach.

Liver- makes bile (fluid that helps break down fats and gets rid of wastes in the body).

Gallbladder- stores bile before releasing it into the duodenum.

Pancreas- A gland that makes enzymes for digestion, and bicarbonate to neutralize stomach acid.



Mouth- salivary enzymes begin carbohydrate digestion and break up food particles.

Stomach- secretes gastric juice and hydrochloric acid, and activates enzymes, continues to breakdown food and kill off any pathogens. Stores and churns food. Enzyme pepsin digests protein.

Small Intestine-
Duodenum- where food is mixed with digestive enzymes and bile.
Ileum- where digested food is absorbed into the blood and lymph.

Large intestine-
Colon- where water is reabsorbed.
Rectum- stores and expels faeces.
Anus- where faeces leave the alimentary canal.
