This guide is for business reports using informal report format, and both in-text and reference-page citations using APA style format. Informal reports usually do not include all the prefatory pages of a formal report, or may include prefatory information on the first body pages rather than separate pages. The content and intent of a specific assignment may dictate some variations from this standard guide specified by the instructor. Please use the points in this guide as a check list.

A. Document

1. White 8.5 x 11 inch paper
2. Word processed and printed on one side only
3. Bound by paperclip, staple, coils, Cerlox, or plastic spines as specified by the instructor
4. One inch margins all sides

B. First Pages

5. Title may appear at the top above the author's name or after the Memo heading (some instructors may require a title page)
6. Memo heading in upper left (alternative to starting with the title)
 - a. Date: text 12 point single spaced
 - b. To: recipient summary
 - c. From: author
 - d. Subject: not the same as the title
7. Introduction
 - a. subject of the report, purpose of report
 - b. direction, limitations, or preview of findings
 - c. text 12 point serif double spaced

C. Report Body

8. Appropriate **section breaks** with headings and sub headings
 - a. major headings centered, all-capitalized, 14 point sans serif font
 - b. headings may include introduction, background, history, findings, conclusions, recommendations, or other appropriate short phrases
 - c. subheadings upper-and-lower-case 14 point sans serif aligned left
 - d. every paragraph does not need a heading
 - e. pages numbered beginning with 1 in Arabic numerals
9. **Short** single-themed paragraphs
 - a. 12 point serif font
 - b. double spaced for marking purposes (real-world business reports would single space)
 - c. 8 point extra spacing between paragraphs (no indents)
10. **All** figures (graphic, photo, statistical graph, table, or chart)
 - a. must be labeled with a figure number above the figure
 - b. must be titled (if it doesn't come with a title, give it one)
 - c. must have the APA source information underneath
 - d. must have an introduction **in the text prior** to the occurrence of the figure

11. Every paragraph containing **summarized or paraphrased** research data must have at least one correctly formatted APA in-text citation.
 - a. (Author, year) author's last name only, **before** the period or other punctuation
 - b. if no known author, use the "first two" non-article words from the title of the work
