Les Manuscrits Du Touat:

Les manuscrits du Touat Saïd Bouterfa, 2005 Saïd Bouterfa nous invite un voyage dans les bibliothèques de la région d'Adrar dans cette partie centrale du Nord de l'Afrique où le commerce transsaharien qui permettait le transit de diverses marchandises d'Afrique du Nord vers le Mali et l'Afrique noire en passant par la région du Touat assura pendant longtemps la prospérité de grandes villes caravanisées telles Ouadane Sijilmassa ou Chinguetti. Ces centres de rassemblement de pèlerins en partance pour La Mecque voyaient affluer les rudes et les étudiants dans leurs écoles, leurs bibliothèques et leurs mosquées et devinrent des villes de première importance pour les musulmans. L'auteur dresse cette occasion un vaste tableau de l'état préoccupant du patrimoine manuscrit actuellement conservé dans ces bibliothèques et présente le projet Manumed Euromed Heritage 1419 1998 dont les objectifs sont la sauvegarde et la conservation préventive des manuscrits de l'ensemble de l'Aire méditerranéenne. Coordonné par le Centre de Conservation du Livre d'Arles France ce projet comprend une dizaine de partenaires parmi lesquels l'Institut de bibliothéconomie d'Alger qui s'assure le concours de la Bibliothèque nationale pour ce qui concerne les aspects liés à la conservation préventive et la restauration ainsi pour la région du Touat la mise en place d'un programme de sauvetage est en cours de réalisation avec comme objectif prioritaire la constitution d'inventaires devant aboutir un catalogage général des manuscrits de la wilaya d'Adrar.
