The white lizard, as it would be easier both to see and to track from high up in the sky.

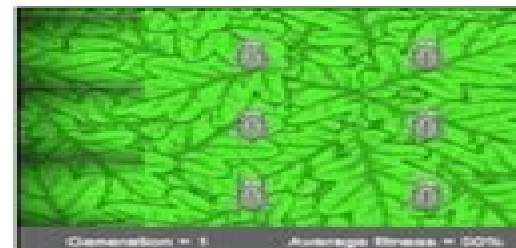
