the daguerreotype in various sciences particularly astronomy and technological innovators who drew on their work in the mechanical arts By the 1860s the daguerreotype had been supplanted by newer technologies Its rise and fall represents an early instance of the ever constant stream of emerging visual technologies Animals, Machines, and AI Erika Quinn, Holly Yanacek, 2021-11-08 Sentient animals machines and robots abound in German literature and culture but there has been surprisingly limited scholarship on non human life forms in German studies This volume extends interdisciplinary research in emotion studies to examine non humans and the affective relationships between humans and non humans in modern German cultural history.
