

ABORTION

Abortion is the termination of a pregnancy before the embryo or unborn child is capable of living independently from the mother. This occurs around the 24th week of pregnancy. Fetus removal is unethical. It is still a cycle of slaying someone who has the right to live, regardless of whether it is a hatchling. It is a difficult topic for women and men who are faced with the moral decision of whether or not to terminate a pregnancy. People to people, the decision to have a fetus removed is really close to home. Prematurely born women should consider twice before engaging in some activities. This includes how women feel, as well as how this will affect the future. Some argue that premature birth is a homicide, while others argue that it is only a hatchling. Premature birth is a criminal act because it results in a large number of infants passing away without ever seeing the world. It also devastates the lives of weak, honest children, particularly in countries where fetal removal is legal.

With the approval of hormonal contraceptives in 1960, women gained more control over their own fertility. In the landmark Roe v. Wade decision, the United States Supreme Court declared restrictive state abortion regulations to be unconstitutional, legalizing medical abortions across the country. Previously, approximately 800,000 illegal abortions were done in the United States each year (Cates et al., 2003). Making it illegal was clearly not going to deter women from getting it done. There are a number of crucial questions to consider. When does one's life begin? How far does reproductive liberty extend? Are there any circumstances in which an abortion would be acceptable? Many people do not have a definite opinion even after extensive thought. In this case, it's sometimes difficult to tell which option is the best. Because abortion is such a contentious issue, I'd like to examine all sides of the debate, highlighting some of the key advantages and disadvantages of each.

First, I'll go over some of the arguments advanced by proponents of abortion rights. They feel that the government should not regulate how women use their bodies. Women should be able to make their own decisions. When it comes to core human rights, reproductive freedom should be treated equally to religious freedom and freedom of speech (among others). You have the right to refuse an abortion if it violates your
