The Wireless World Simon J. Potter, David Clayton, Friederike Kind-Kovacs, Vincent Kuitenbrouwer, Nelson Ribeiro, Rebecca Scales, Andrea Stanton, 2022-08-18 *The Wireless World* sets out a new research agenda for the history of international broadcasting and for radio history more generally.
