fear oil coercion deeply despite the adaptive functions of the market Together these two variables predict a state s coercive vulnerability which determines how willing the state will be to accept the costs and risks attendant on various potential strategies Only those great powers with large deficits and highly disruptible imports will adopt the most extreme strategy direct control of oil through territorial conquest
