

"The Religious Settlement of 1559 did not solve the problem of religion in Elizabethan England." How Far do you agree? (16 marks)

The Religious Settlement of 1559 did not solve the problem of religion for the Protestant denomination of Christianity. This is because the queen was the Supreme Governor of the Church of England. The Protestants wanted the queen to rule the church and so she did. Plus if any future monarch was able they would rightly be Head of the Church of England, playing to Protestant wishes. The Religious Settlement did not solve the problem of religion for the Protestants because if the queen was the governor of the Church of England, she would make the laws that suited her.

The Religious Settlement did not solve the problem of religion for the Puritans. This is because the new Church had a very Catholic feel, the Puritans did not believe in churches being lavish as they believed people could not focus on their prayers. To add the Puritans did not believe in a Head of the Church, so they would have disagreed with all Elizabeth's proposals, however the Puritans were a very small group and they were divided, so Elizabeth had no fear of them because of their weaknesses. Therefore she was not concerned that the religious settlement was right or not right for them.

The new church may have resolved the dilemma of religion. This is because the religious settlement did not cause any immediate or wide-spread anti-Elizabeth sentiment. The new church imposed recusancy fines, meaning failure to attend church meant a fine. This forced people to attend the church, a one shilling fine was a large amount in the period. Plus people did not want to stop attending church altogether as religion was at the centre of life in 1559.

The religious settlement did not solve the problem of religion. This is because the pope at the time took no action against Elizabeth. This is because he thought England would still be in turmoil over the religious settlement and Elizabeth would be forced to change the country back to Catholic. The religious settlement did not solve the problem of religion because religious leaders did not take any action.

This answer was awarded 8 marks out of 16. The student takes a narrative approach instead of an analytical one. There is no clear introduction and conclusion so the intent cannot be stated and nor can any links. The first paragraph does not say why the Catholics would accept the Religious Settlement but the third point is a very good one and the strongest presented in the essay. The essay needs to focus on how Elizabeth failed to enforce the settlement rigidly and the impact upon its chances of success.

"Political grievances were the main reason of the Revolt of the Northern Earls in 1569" How Far do you agree? (16 marks)

The factors why the Revolt of the Northern Earls took place included religion, politics and economics. All three had a part to play in the Revolt of the Northern Earls in 1569. I agree that political grievances was the main reason of the Revolt of the Northern Earls. This is because Elizabeth had weakened the Earls powers. For example the Earl of Northumberland lost an important post in defending the border of Scotland. Political grievances were the main reason the Revolt took place because if the Earls had lost some of their power, their only way of getting it back was to take control of England by over-throwing Elizabeth.

However the Earls were never sure to over-throw Elizabeth and replace her with Mary. This is because Elizabeth had moved Mary to a new prison and they realised they could not rescue her. The main reason of the revolt this shows was religious. This is because it was attempted to establish Mary as the Queen of England, especially a Catholic queen like her. This is reinforced by the fact the rebels wore Catholic emblems and were hoping to receive help by Catholic Spain. The main reason for the revolt was political grievances as they feared for their lives. This is shown when Elizabeth found out about the Norfolk plan, she summoned the Earls to court. This made the Earls fear being executed so their only option was to revolt.

Furthermore they were right as Elizabeth confiscated their land and executed around 600 rebels. To add she had the Earl of Northumberland executed in 1572. The main reason of the revolt was for political reasons because of the suspicion between the Earls and Elizabeth, exceeding tension.

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
