Important and Beneficial Biological Functions of Microbes

- Digestion: Animals have microorganisms in their digestive tract, that are essential for digestion and vitamin synthesis.
 - Cellulose digestion by ruminants (cows, rabbits, etc.)
 - Vitamin K and B synthesis in humans.
- Medicine: Many antibiotics and other drugs are naturally synthesized by microbes.
