## Human Body Organs

### Kidneys



**K**idneys are the body's natural filters. They regulate the balance of fluids and waste in the body. They are located in the back of the body, one on each side of the spine. They filter out waste from the blood and return the clean blood to the body. They also help to regulate blood pressure and produce hormones that control the body's metabolism.

### Stomach



**S**tomach is a muscular organ that is part of the digestive system. It is located in the upper abdomen. It receives food from the mouth and breaks it down into smaller pieces. It then sends the food to the small intestine where it is further digested. The stomach also produces stomach acid which helps to break down the food.

### Small Intestine



**S**mall intestine is a long, thin, coiled tube that is part of the digestive system. It is located in the lower abdomen. It receives food from the stomach and breaks it down into even smaller pieces. It then sends the food to the large intestine where it is further digested. The small intestine also produces enzymes that help to break down the food.

### Large Intestine



**L**arge intestine is a thick, muscular tube that is part of the digestive system. It is located in the lower abdomen. It receives food from the small intestine and breaks it down into even smaller pieces. It then sends the food to the rectum where it is further digested. The large intestine also produces enzymes that help to break down the food.

### Heart



**H**earth is a muscular organ that pumps blood throughout the body. It is located in the center of the chest. It has four chambers: two atria and two ventricles. The atria receive blood from the body and the lungs, and the ventricles pump the blood out to the body and the lungs. The heart also has a network of blood vessels that carry the blood to and from the rest of the body.

### Liver



**L**iver is a large, reddish-brown organ that is located in the upper right abdomen. It is the largest internal organ in the body. It has many functions, including filtering toxins from the blood, producing bile to help with digestion, and storing energy. The liver also produces most of the proteins in the blood.

### Lungs



**L**ungs are two large, spongy organs that are located in the chest. They are responsible for taking in oxygen from the air and removing carbon dioxide from the body. The lungs are made of a soft, spongy tissue that allows them to expand and contract as they breathe. They are also covered in a thin layer of moisture that helps to keep them from drying out.

### Brain



**B**rain is a soft, pinkish-grey organ that is located in the head. It is the control center of the body, responsible for all of the thoughts, feelings, and actions that we experience. The brain is made up of billions of neurons that are connected to each other in a complex network. It is also surrounded by a layer of protective tissue called the meninges.
