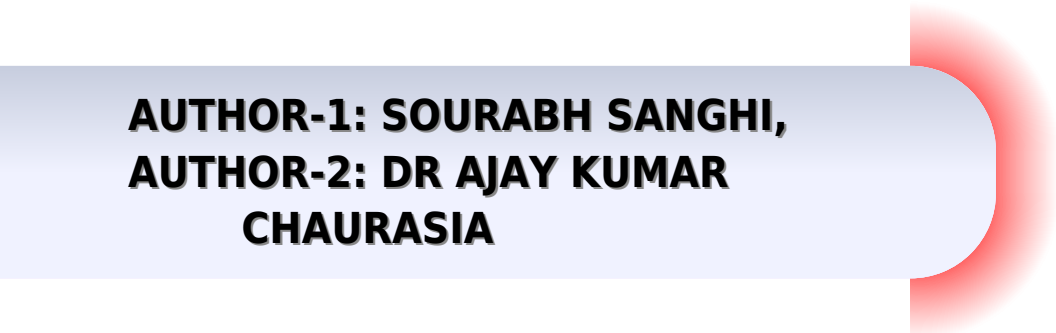

The Literary and Human Legacy of Clara Sereni Giulia Po DeLisle, Susan Briziarelli, 2025-03-18 Clara Sereni lived an extraordinary life in extraordinary times Born in Rome in 1946 she grew up in a prominent family of Jewish intellectuals whose influential role in Italian politics and in the anti fascist resistance could not but inform Sereni s own future social and political engagement Coming of age during the turbulent Sixties Sereni embraced the struggle for women s rights social justice and political reform championing Eduardo Galeano s notion that utopia always stands at the horizon and one must keep walking to reach it Activist journalist writer translator but also musician disability rights champion home maker and wife her multiple and often conflicting roles emerge in a rich and multifaceted writing increasingly balanced between the public and the private history with a capital H and personal memoir Her first major success *Casalinghitudine Keeping House* explores the juncture of the public and the personal as important historical moments merge with her workaday memories of cooking Her remarkable historical novel *Il Gioco dei Regni The Game of Kingdoms* traces her family history from the early 20th century through the post war period chronicling their personal lives and their involvement in Italian politics and Jewish intellectual life Subsequent works such as *Taccuino di un ultimista Notebook of a Meek Woman* and *Passami il sale Pass me the Salt* tackle the difficulties of negotiating life as a political figure wife and mother of a disabled son In works such as *Eppure And Yet Le Merendanze Afternoon Snacks* and *Una storia chiusa A Closed Story* as well as *Il lupo mercante The Mongering Wolf* and *Via Ripetta 155 155 Ripetta Street* she again intertwines private experiences and public circumstances raising questions related to gender class disability the elderly and sustainability This is the first volume that brings together the critical aspects of Clara Sereni s work providing a comprehensive view of the writer the intellectual the politician and the woman As we reflect on the 20th century Sereni s long spanning writing career stands as an important document of its struggles its conflicts and like Sereni herself its enduring idealism

Ribak,2009 This book provides current information about the three areas mentioned in the title Neuronal Migration and Development Degenerative Brain Diseases and Neural Plasticity and Regeneration The chapters about brain development examine the cellular and molecular mechanisms by which neurons are generated from the ventricular zone in the forebrain and migrate to their destinations in the cerebral cortex This description of cortical development also includes a discussions of the Cajal Retzius cell Another chapter provides insight about the development of another forebrain region the hypothalamus The remaining chapters of this section examine the clinical relevance of brain development in certain disease states in humans neural tube defects and the normal and abnormal development of human electroencephalographic recordings during the first year of age The second section on degenerative disorders of the brain begins with details about the dopaminergic neurons in the substantia nigra and their loss in Parkinson's disease Two subsequent chapters describe changes in brain aging including changes in the numbers of myelinated axons Other chapters in this section describe important cellular and molecular changes found in Alzheimer's disease and human epilepsy Together these chapters summarize much of our current knowledge about the major molecular and cellular changes found in several degenerative diseases of the brain The last section addresses the issues of brain plasticity and regeneration in the adult brain and begins with a chapter on how the brain's own stem cells provide newly generated neurons to the

hippocampal dentate gyrus and how these neurons become integrated into neural circuitry The following two chapters examine some of the neuroplastic changes that take place in motor and sensory cortices of awake behaving primates The concluding two chapters address the issue of regeneration in the injured spinal cord and the factors that may contribute to its success

Humans, Horses and Events Management Katherine Dashper, Guðrún Helgadóttir, Ingibjörg Sigurðardóttir, 2021-03-12 Horses are perhaps the most common non human animal to feature in planned events but although there is considerable research on equestrian sport there is virtually none on equestrian events This book begins to address this gap using the National Championships of the Icelandic Horse as an extended case study to explain in depth the process of managing an event as well as the larger theoretical implications of events management Drawing on diverse viewpoints and theoretical perspectives the book draws wider comparisons to connect events management to larger themes in the social sciences such as human animal relations nationalism place branding event impacts event experience and inclusion and exclusion The book is a contribution to two fields In relation to human animal studies it focuses on how the Icelandic horse breed is marketed and celebrated through top tier competition whereas from an events management perspective it considers the role of the event in community building the practical and theoretical aspects of running a sustainable equestrian event and the issues that arise in multispecies event contexts
