

3 basic niches in a food chain order:

Producer: produces food

Consumer: consumes producers or other consumers

Decomposer: breaks down dead organisms and recycle nutrients where they can be used by other living organisms. Ex: bacteria, fungi, mushrooms

Food chain - a food relationship where one organism serves as food for another organism.

Food Web: shows many food chains and how they interconnect with each other. Arrows always point to the predator or arrows always point to the flow of decreasing energy. Food webs show that organisms eat more than one type of food. The bottom of the food web/chain population is the most numerous. The top of the food web/chain is the least numerous. If there were a decline in the mouse population, then there would be a decrease in the frog population because owls will eat the other source of food. There would be a decrease in the snake and hawk population because they depend on mice.
