Getting By Mckenzie, Lisa, 2015-01-14 While the 1% rule poor neighbourhoods have become the subject of public concern and media scorn blamed for society's ills This unique book redresses the balance Lisa Mckenzie lived on the St Ann's estate in Nottingham for more than 20 years Her insider status enables us to hear the stories of its residents often wary of outsiders St Ann's has been stigmatised as a place where gangs guns drugs single mothers and those unwilling or unable to make something of their lives reside Yet in this same community we find strong resourceful ambitious people who are getting by often with humour and despite facing brutal austerity

Class, Politics, and the Decline of Deference in England, 1968-2000 Florence Sutcliffe-Braithwaite, 2018 In late twentieth century England inequality was rocketing yet some have suggested that the politics of class was declining in significance while others argue that class identities lost little power Neither interpretation is satisfactory class remained important to ordinary people's narratives about social change and their own identities throughout the period 1968-2000 but in changing ways Using self narratives drawn from a wide range of sources the raw materials of sociological studies transcripts from oral history projects Mass Observation and autobiography the book examines class identities and narratives of social change between 1968 and 2000 showing that by the end of the period class was often seen as an historical identity related to background and heritage and that many felt strict class boundaries had blurred quite profoundly since 1945 Class snobberies went underground as many people from all backgrounds began to assert that what was important was authenticity individuality and ordinariness In fact Sutcliffe Braithwaite argues that it is more useful to understand the cultural changes of these years through the lens of the decline of deference which transformed people's attitudes towards class and towards politics The study also examines the claim that Thatcher and New Labour wrote class out of politics arguing that this simple and highly political narrative misses important points Thatcher was driven by political ideology and necessity to try to dismiss the importance of class while the New Labour project was good at listening to voters particularly swing voters in marginal seats and echoing back what they were increasingly saying about the blurring of class lines and the importance of ordinariness But this did not add up to an abandonment of a majoritarian project as New Labour reoriented their political project to emphasize using the state to empower the individual

London's Aylesbury Estate Michael Rymn, 2020-09-18 This book looks beyond the Aylesbury's public face by examining its rise and fall from the perspective of those who knew it based largely on the oral testimony and memoir of residents and former residents youth and community workers borough Councillors officials police officers and architects What emerges is not a simple story of definitive failures but one of texture and complexity struggle and accord family and friends and of rapidly changing circumstances The study spans the years 1967 to 2010 from the estate's ambitious inception until the first of its blocks were pulled down It is a period rarely dealt with by historians of council housing who have typically confined themselves to the years before or after the 1979 watershed As such it demonstrates how shifts in

Learning in the 'Bottom' Reading Group Jess Anderson, 2025-02-28 The common practice of ability grouped reading in UK schools often termed guided reading influences children's sense of identity feelings and progress as readers Drawing on a rich ethnographic study of three primary classrooms this book reopens a critical inquiry into ability grouped reading that has been quiet since the 1990s when guided reading in literacy education became established practice in the UK and the US Through the lens of children's agency in accommodating resisting and at times transforming such reading pedagogy the book shows how readers are shaped by ability grouped reading and by the more egalitarian reading pedagogies introduced in the study Children's individual and collective experiences are brought to life through extended narratives that attend as closely to gesture posture visage silences and prosody of speech as to spoken words The book ends with a provocation how literacy pedagogy might change if reflexive noticing and dismantling of hierarchies become the compass of pedagogical change This demands attention to structural inequalities around race gender and class and a turn towards deep listening to children As well as being a valuable read for scholars of the sociology of childhood and education it should appeal to anyone concerned with making education more equitable including teachers school leaders parents carers and policymakers **Social**

All Our Welfare Peter Beresford, 2016-01-29 The UK welfare state is under sustained ideological and political attack In *All Our Welfare* Peter Beresford explores the establishment and trajectory of the postwar welfare state and offers a blueprint for participatory social policy in the future By showing that early welfare policies resulted from popular revulsion against the inequity of the market and associated poor laws Beresford reveals that the welfare state was ultimately undermined by its failure to engage the people it was intended to help Noting the subsequent similar failure of neoliberal social policy to engage people in improving their own welfare Beresford draws on the pioneering theories and practices of current welfare service user movements to outline participatory approaches to social policy theory knowledge development policy practice and support identifying a series of principles that could underpin them and offering inclusive models for sustainable change Also including fascinating vignettes from his own family's experience Beresford demonstrates the value of user knowledge

Cash Not Care Mo Stewart, 2016-09-14 Mo Stewart is a former healthcare professional a disabled female veteran and an independent researcher This book is the culmination of six years of self funded research and the evidence exposes the influence of corporate America since 1992 with the future welfare reforms of the UK The impact of the enforced austerity measures of the UK government is identified as they negatively affect the welfare and the survival of the chronically sick and disabled population in receipt of welfare benefits when unfit to work The

research has informed welfare reform debates in the House of Lords and the House of Commons since 2011 and contributed to the evidence used by the United Nations to investigate the UK government for breaches of the Human Rights of sick and disabled people Endorsed by the disabled community and by academics the research has identified the adoption of lethal social policies copied from American social security policies and linked to the death of thousands of the most vulnerable of all as the UK welfare state is systematically demolished as all planned over thirty years ago by a previous Conservative government

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
