Europe in the sixteenth century Mennonites migrated around the world even as their religious teachings historically emphasized their separateness from others The idea of Mennonite food became a way of maintaining community identity even as unfamiliar environments obliged Mennonites to borrow and learn from their neighbours Looking at Mennonites past and present Epp shows that foodstuffs cuisine and foodways practices depend on historical and cultural context She explores how diets have evolved as a result of migration settlement and mission how food and gender identities relate to both power and fear how cookbooks and recipes are full of social meaning how experiences and memories of food scarcity shape identity and how food is an expression of religious beliefs as a symbol in ritual and in acts of charity From zwieback to tamales and from sauerkraut to spring rolls Eating Like a Mennonite reveals food as a complex ingredient in ethnic religious and personal identities with the ability to create both bonds and boundaries between people
