Progress, Change and Development in Early Childhood Education and Care Elizabeth Coates,Dorothy Faulkner,2017-10-02 In 2000 the Millennium Development Goals set out targets aimed at creating a safer more prosperous and more equitable world If these goals were to be achieved children s lives would indeed be transformed In this collection achievements against these targets are identified with each contributor examining the progress made in early years provision in Australia China England Greece the Netherlands Portugal South Africa and Sweden They highlight the priorities and agendas of their respective governments and focus on the trends and issues which are particularly relevant to each situation thereby revealing the social and educational inequalities that persist across countries A common theme running through this volume concerns the political tensions that arise when governments and educators hold fundamentally different views about the nature and purpose of early years education and the needs of children and families It is clear that although the past two decades have seen many changes in attitude towards the importance of the early years of life politically economically and environmentally much still remains to be done if the Millennium Development Goals for young children and their families are to be fully met Despite this this volume demonstrates that those who work in this area continue to experience a deep concern for the well being of young children which transcends cultures frontiers and political and sectarian divides This book was originally published as a
