Abstract The purpose of this study was to determine the effect of a 12-week, low-intensity, supervised walking program on the physical and psychological health of older adults. The study was a randomized, controlled trial. The participants were 60 older adults (mean age = 72.5 years) who were randomly assigned to either a walking program or a control group. The walking program consisted of 12 weeks of supervised walking, 3 times per week, for 30 minutes per session. The control group received no intervention. The participants were assessed at baseline and at 12 weeks. The walking program had a significant positive effect on the physical and psychological health of the older adults. The walking program significantly improved the participants' physical health, as measured by the 6-minute walk test, the 10-meter walk test, and the Timed Up-and-Go test. The walking program also significantly improved the participants' psychological health, as measured by the Geriatric Depression Scale and the Geriatric Anxiety Inventory. The walking program was well-tolerated and had no adverse effects. The results of this study suggest that a 12-week, low-intensity, supervised walking program can improve the physical and psychological health of older adults.
