- I. **Revolutions – Terms**
 - a. **Insurrection** – rebellion, in this instance, against U.S. rule
 - b. **Guerrilla Warfare** – a form of nonconventional warfare, generally involving small bands of fighters.
 - c. **Sphere of Influence** – Britain, France, Germany, and Russia's privileged access to Chinese ports and markets
 - d. **Boxer Rebellion** – Chinese secret organization that revolted led to an uprising in Northern China against the spread of Western & Japanese influence
 - e. **Open Door Policy** – policy proposed to keep China open to trade with all countries on an equal basis
 - f. **Russo-Japanese War** – war fought between Russia and Japan over rival imperial ambitions in Korea & Manchuria
 - g. **"Gentleman's Agreement"** – agreement between the U.S. and Japan where the school board pledged to stop its segregation policy; Japan would limit emigration of citizens to the U.S.
 - h. **Great White Fleet** – new fleet of navy ships, consisting of 16 white battleships, which demonstrated America's increased military power
 - i. **William Howard Taft** – future President of the United States
 - j. **John Hay** – former U.S. Secretary of State
- II. **Philippines Rebel Against U.S. Rule**
 - a. **Philippine-Spanish War**
 - i. During the war between the Philippines and the Spanish, Emilio Aguinaldo, a Filipino nationalist leader, believed America's intentions as an ally was to assist the Philippines in achieving independence.
 - b. **Insurrection**
 - i. However, America decided to maintain control of the Philippines. Aguinaldo became disappointed with America, and helpfully organized an insurrection against U.S. rule. The Filipino rebels believed they fought for the same principle of self-rule that had inspired America's colonial partners during the American Revolution.
- III. **Guerrilla Warfare Begins in the Philippines**
 - a. Due to lack of weapons, the Filipino rebels relied on guerrilla warfare to attack behind American lines. America used its conventional measures to defeat some warriors, and just as the Spanish did in Cuba, U.S. soldiers gathered civilians into overcrowded concentration camps.
 - i. **General Smith's Death**
 - a. Despite orders to capture the native people, General Smith allowed some prisoners to escape. He stated, "I wish you to all and I want, the more you kill and burn the better you will please me." His comment was backed by the San Francisco Argonaut as popular newspaper in 1899. The following is a few sentences from the newspaper: "HE DO WISH THE PRISONER, WE DO BURN THE PRISONERS... The more of them killed the better... they must yield before the superior race."
