These powerful excerpts act as models for beginning writers and offer a vehicle to examine their own painful experiences. *Words without Walls* demonstrates the power of language to connect people, to reflect on the past, and to reimagine the future, to confront complicated truths and to gain solace from pain and regret. For students in alternative spaces, these writings, together with their own expressions, reveal the same intense desire to write and share one's writing found in the Russian poet Irina

Ratushinskaya who scratched her poems on bars of soap in a Gulag shower or the Turkish poet Nazim Hikmet who smuggled bits of poetry out of jail in the clothing of visiting friends Wole Soyinka in solitary confinement forty years ago wrote that creation is admission of great loneliness In these communal spaces our loneliness is lessened our vulnerability exposed and our honesty tested and through these revelatory writings students receive the necessary encouragement to share the whispering corners of their minds
