

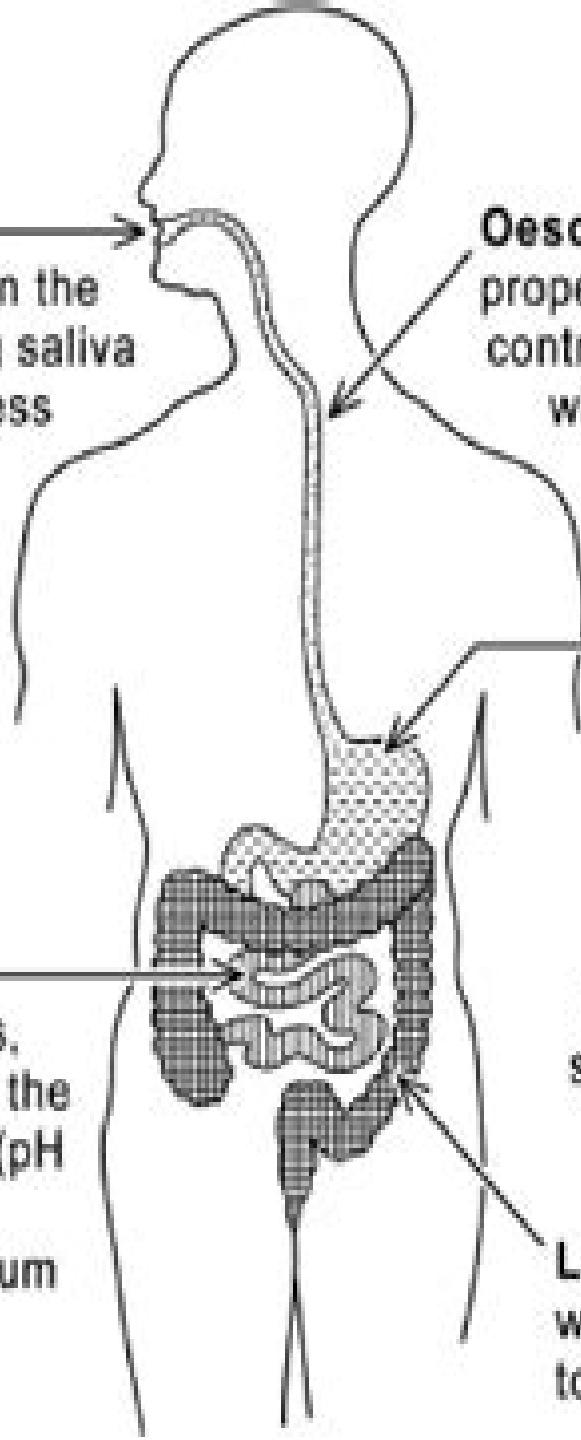
**Mouth:**—  
where soil may be masticated in the presence of enzyme-containing saliva at a pH of 6.5. The entire process in the mouth lasts from a few seconds to minutes.

**Oesophagus:**  
propelled by rhythmic muscular contractions called peristalsis, soil will move rapidly (a few seconds) through the oesophagus to reach the stomach.

**Stomach:**  
stronger peristaltic motions churn and mix the soil with enzyme-enriched, acidic (pH 1 - 5) gastric juices. Stomach constituents can be retained for a few minutes or several hours.

**Small intestine:**—  
comprised of three components, constituents can be retained in the duodenum for 30 - 45 minutes (pH 4 - 5.5), the jejunum for 1.5 - 2 hours (pH 5.5 - 7.0) and the ileum for 5 - 7 hours (pH 7.0 - 7.5).

**Large intestine:**  
where absorption of water leads to the formation of faeces.
