Intracranial Problems Increased intracranial pressure (ICP 5-15mmHg)

 - change in loc
 - · check GCS!
 - eye opening response

- slight confusion (most pronounced sign)
- drowsy
- sleepy
- change in VS (Cushing's triad)
 - · systolic hypertension w/ widening pulse pressure
