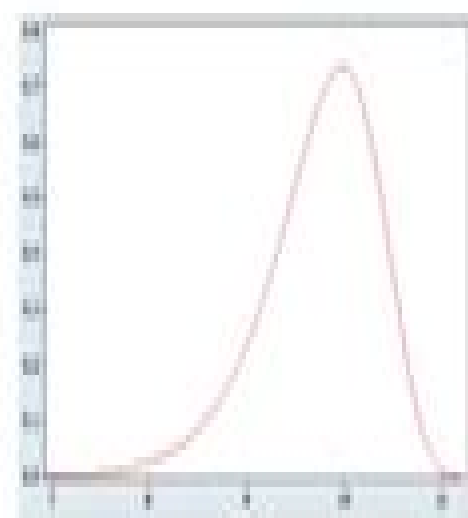
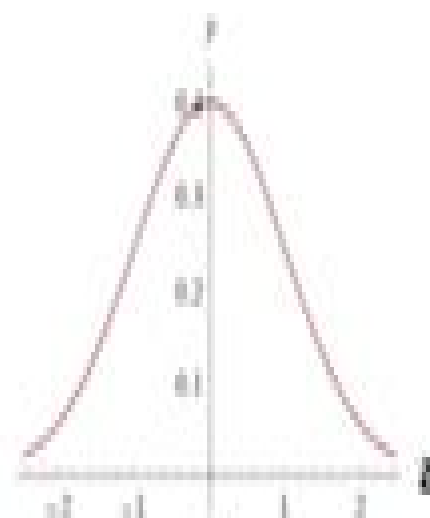


On a class exam, students' scores followed a Gaussian distribution. The class averaged 77 points with a standard deviation of 5.

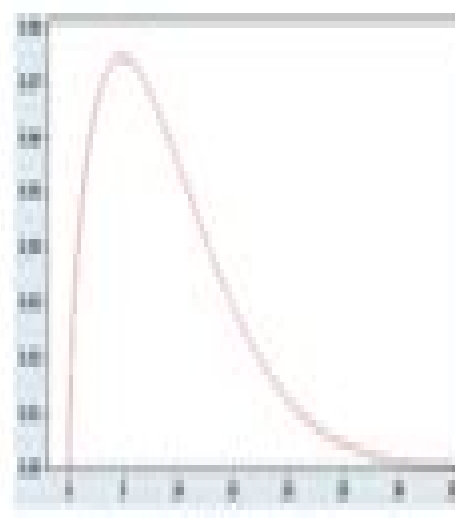
Select the normal distribution that is being used to model the distribution of exam scores. Use the standard deviation to check the scale.
