INTRODUCTION- (2 MARKS)

A paragraph to explain WHY you chose to do this study e.g. show why this study is important. Try to explain why you have chosen to investigate this topic and what you expect to find. You can make a prediction or suggest possible outcomes. It might be appropriate to refer to a geographical theory or model i.e. how info will be collected.

THE AIM - (2 MARKS)

The aim of the SBA is a statement made which you wish to test (i.e. for you to prove or disprove) and which will allow for the collection of primary data

You are required to formulate ONE simple and clear aim which would allow for collection of data and developed in the Presentation of Data.

The aim must have at least TWO descriptive words showing how you will collect the data and how you will present this data in order to answer the question or problem e.g.

- How the information will be collected words such as identify, determine, find out, examine,
- investigate, observe.

b) How the information will be presented – words such as describe, explain, illustrate, discuss, compare. The aim must also state the specific geographic feature that is being studied and the name of the town or village and the country in which the study is located e.g.
