Faces of the Wolf Bernard Charlier, 2015-03-31 In his study of the human non human relationships in Mongolia Bernard Charlier explores the role of the wolf in the ways nomadic herders relate to their natural environment and to themselves The wolf as the enemy of the herds and a prestigious prey is at the core of two technical relationships herding and hunting endowed with particular cosmological ideas The study of these relationships casts a new light on the ways herders perceive and relate to domestic and wild animals It convincingly undermines any attempt to consider humans and non humans as entities belonging a priori to autonomous spheres of existence which would reify the nature society boundary into a phenomenal order of things and so justify the identity of western epistemology Wolf Conflicts Ketil Skogen, Olve Krange, Helene Figari, 2017-05-01 Wolf populations have recently made a comeback in Northern Europe and North America These large carnivores can cause predictable conflicts by preying on livestock and competing with hunters for game But their arrivals often become deeply embedded in more general societal tensions which arise alongside processes of social change that put considerable pressure on rural communities and on the rural working class in particular Based on research and case studies conducted in Norway Wolf Conflicts discusses various aspects of this complex picture including conflicts over land use and conservation and more general patterns of hegemony and resistance in modern societies **The Ashgate Research Companion to Planning Theory** Patsy Healey, 2016-11-03 At a time of potentially radical changes in the ways in which humans interact with their environments through financial environmental and or social crises the raison d'être of spatial planning faces significant conceptual and empirical challenges This Companion presents a multidimensional collection of critical narratives of conceptual challenges for spatial planning The authors draw on various disciplinary traditions and theoretical frames to explore different ways of conceptualising spatial planning and the challenges it faces Through problematising planning itself the values which underpin planning and theory practice relations contributions make visible the limits of established planning theories and illustrate how by thinking about new issues or about issues in new ways spatial planning might be advanced both theoretically and practically There cannot be definitive answers to the conceptual challenges posed but the authors in this collection provoke critical questions and debates over important issues for spatial planning and its future A key question is not so much what planning theory is but what might planning theory do in times of uncertainty and complexity An underlying rationale is that planning theory and practice are intrinsically connected The Companion is presented in three linked parts issues which arise from an interactive understanding of the relations between planning ideas and the political institutional contexts in which such ideas are put to work key concepts in current theorising from mainly poststructuralist perspectives and what discussion on complexity may offer planning theory and practice *Biosecurity* Andrew Dobson, Kezia Barker, Sarah L. Des vies océaniques Fabien Clouette, 2025-03-14 T00:00:00+01:00 Un phoque qui grandit parmi les surfeurs un dauphin qui préfère vivre dans les ports que parmi ses congénères un groupe d'orques qui attaque des voiliers le milieu maritime a cela de formidable que les rencontres avec de grands mammifères y sont plus videntes que sur la terre ferme où on ne s'approche pas aisément d'un fauve ou d'un loup En mer au contraire phoques et cétacés viennent volontiers au contact particulièrement depuis la fin des grandes exploitations baleinières Cet ouvrage va leur rencontrer et propose de retracer la vie personnelle de quatre d'entre eux la destinée exceptionnelle car partagée avec les humains You Zafar Kalon et Gladis sont des personnages du littoral atlantique

dont on lira la trajectoire d'une vie souvent heurtée et parfois tragique toujours troublante. Leur parcours déplace la catégorie socio-anthropologique de l'animal que l'on a tendance à considérer comme se conformant aux lois de l'instinct et de la survie. Au fil de ces biographies, des questions inédites émergent : quelle relation possible avec un mammifère sauvage qui vit dans un monde aussi hostile pour l'humain que l'océan ? Ces animaux poursuivent-ils des existences qui les font déborder des frontières de leur espace ? En retour, ce sont les politiques de conservation tout autant que celles de la pêche ou de la plaisance ou du tourisme qui sont discutées : comment agir, soigner, préserver, cohabiter avec ces mammifères singuliers qui nous interpellent ? Fabien Clouette est anthropologue chargé de recherches au CNRS ESO Rennes et spécialiste des terrains maritimes. Il est également cinéaste et auteur de romans publiés aux Éditions de l'Ogre.

Le loup est revenu Anne Vallaeys, 2013-10-02. La bergère humecte la cigarette qu'elle vient de rouler. C'est harassant, dit-elle, d'avoir le loup comme adversaire. *Canis lupus* est revenu. Sur l'ensemble des massifs alpins, des Pyrénées au Cantal jusqu'en Vosges, dix-neuf meutes sauvages peuplent vingt-neuf territoires. Mais l'expansion géographique du loup se mesure surtout en milliers d'ovins tombés sous ses crocs. Symbole d'une nature reconquise pour ses partisans, cauchemar pour les gardiens de troupeaux, la réapparition du prédateur divise dans les alpages. La montagne serait-elle redevenue le lieu d'un combat ? Troupeaux et bergers devront-ils désertar, abandonner les estives au profit du sauvage vorace ? Anne Vallaeys a parcouru les confins du Mercantour en Ubaye où depuis toujours vivent des générations de bergers et d'éleveurs. Sur la trace des loups, jour après jour, la voyageuse a gravi les vallons, contourné les falaises et les précipices. Pour comprendre, son récit brouille les représentations convenues du prédateur, du loup et de ses proies, les brebis. Il démonte les stéréotypes et les faux semblants d'une nature vraie qui aurait tous les droits. Lauréate du prix Joseph Kessel pour Médecins sans frontières, la biographie Fayard. Anne Vallaeys est l'auteur, entre autres, de *Dieulefit ou le miracle du silence* Fayard et Edward dans sa jungle Fayard.

Les alpages à l'épreuve des loups Marc Vincent, 2011-03-07. Le quart de couverture indique : « Ce livre se fait l'choix du conflit très médiatisé qui oppose depuis 1992 le monde du pastoralisme aux protecteurs de ces prédateurs. Sur la base d'une documentation très détaillée, le résultat de plusieurs années d'enquêtes auprès d'éleveurs de bergers et de nombreux acteurs des territoires montagnards, l'auteur montre toute la complexité de la proximité entre les troupeaux domestiques et les loups animaux sauvages intégralement protégés par la convention de Berne. Ce texte ratifié alors qu'ils avaient disparu du territoire national engage les pouvoirs publics, leur sauvegarde. Mais dans le même temps, l'état reconnaît officiellement le rôle du pastoralisme sur l'environnement, l'entretien de l'espace, la prévention des risques d'avalanche ou d'incendie, la protection d'espèces emblématiques. Autrement dit, les loups comme les moutons ont leur place. Or, les attaques de loups affectent considérablement le pastoralisme au quotidien et les mesures de protection proposées par l'état remettent en cause ce qui jusque-là était considéré comme les bonnes pratiques des bergers. L'auteur est convaincu de la nécessité de mettre en œuvre une politique de gestion active de ces prédateurs pour une coexistence pacifique entre pastoralistes et protecteurs des loups. Il définit les bases de ce qui

il appelle la lupotechnie et nous emmène sur les chemins de la transhumance provençale qui conduisent bergers et brebis de la plaine de Crau au parc naturel régional du Queyras. Loin de tout folklore archaïsant, il rend compte de la singularité de cette phase d'élevage, la fois difficile et indispensable en présentant le métier de berger d'alpage dont les conditions de travail et de vie sont finalement assez bien connues. Il s'adresse des spécialistes de la question, chercheurs en sociologie de l'environnement ou en gestion de l'élevage et institutions chargées de ce dossier sensible. Mais son ouvrage intéressera aussi des lecteurs curieux de mieux comprendre les enjeux environnementaux de l'agriculture.

Histoire des parcs nationaux Raphaël Larrère, Martine Berlan-Darqué, Bernadette Lizet, 2009-04-14. Cet ouvrage livre les clés de l'évolution des politiques de la nature dans les parcs nationaux français et des controverses qui l'ont marqué. Une première partie relate l'histoire et les mémoires des parcs métropolitains avec l'étude de la conception des premiers projets de parcs Vanoise, Cévennes et Pyrénées, ainsi que l'analyse des difficultés rencontrées pour créer un parc en mer d'Iroise. L'adoption problématique de la biodiversité comme norme d'action depuis les années 1990, avec pour exemple les parcs des Cévennes et des Pyrénées, fait l'objet des chapitres suivants. La conclusion retrace l'itinéraire qui a conduit les parcs nationaux de la protection de la nature à la gestion de la biodiversité. Elle met en évidence le défi qui reste à relever : transformer en partenaires des parcs des usagers qui leur furent longtemps hostiles. Ce livre s'adresse ceux qui sont concernés par la préservation et la gestion de la biodiversité dans les parcs nationaux et dans les autres espaces protégés. Il intéressera plus généralement les gestionnaires et les militants qui cherchent une façon d'habiter la nature et d'en tirer parti tout en la respectant.
