 A human body cell contains 23 pairs of homologous chromosomes or a total of 45 chromosomes.

"Note: Homologous chromosomes are pairs of chromosomes in which one chromosome comes from the mother and one comes from the father. Homologous chromosomes are similar but not identical. Each carries the same genes in the same order, but the allales for each trait may not be the same.

2. What occurs during mitotic cell divisions:

During mitosis and cell division, the chromosomes duplicate and then separate. At the end of mitosis, a new nucleus forms around each new set of chromosomes and then the cell divides in a process called cytokinesis. This creates two new identical daughter cells.
