Tigary: The Panarchy of War Mirjam Van Reisen, Munyaradzi Mawere, 2024-11-17 The Tigray War 2020 2022 left a deep and lasting impact not only on Tigray but also on the wider Horn of Africa In this second book in a three part series the authors examine the devastation wrought by the war on Tigray's cultural heritage and identity.
