Preparasyon:

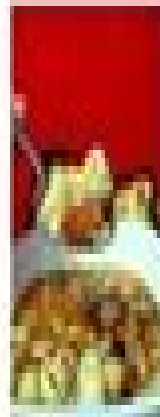
1. Melt 2 tbsp butter in a little vegetable oil.
2. Add the diced onion, stir for 3 min.
3. Add garlic, stir for 2 min.
4. Add ground beef.
5. Stir and add beef broth powder and pepper, stir.
6. Add diced sausage, beef broth and tomato sauce.
7. Stir until it simmers. Add butter. Cover for 10 min.
8. Add cooked pasta.
9. Stir and let it simmer covered for 5 min.
10. Add the herbs.
11. Stir and cover for 5 min.
12. Drain cottage cheese and add to the soup.
13. Stir and cover for other 4 min.
14. Top with mozzarella cheese.
15. Cover, remove from heat, and let it sit for 5 min.

Ingredients:

- ◆ 2 cups beef broth
- ◆ 1/2 cup tomato paste sauce
- ◆ 2 tbsp beef broth bouillon
- ◆ 2 tbsp salted butter
- ◆ 16 oz large curd cottage cheese (500 g)
- ◆ 1/2 dried parmesan
- ◆ 1/2 tsp pepper
- ◆ 1 tbsp minced garlic
- ◆ 1/2 tsp kosher salt
- ◆ 1 lb ground beef (1/2 kg)
- ◆ 1 cup mozzarella cheese
- ◆ 2 dried chorizo smoked sausage
- ◆ 2 tbsp leaf herbs, crushed
- ◆ 2 tbsp bay leaves, crushed
- ◆ 3 cups cooked pasta

Serving Suggestion:

Bread, Sprinkled double cream cheese (or cream cheese), dried(10), add some dried herbs. Parmesan, chili powder. Place in oven for 10 min at 325°.
