Lilian Thuram, né en Guadeloupe en 1972, a connu une carrière prestigieuse de footballeur international : champion du monde en 1998, champion d'Europe en 2000, vice-champion du monde en 2006, ainsi que de nombreux titres en club. Il a détenu jusqu'au 28 octobre 2005 le record de sélections en équipe de France, record détenu aujourd'hui par Sandrine Soubeyran, capitaine de l'équipe de France féminine. En 2008, il a créé la Fondation Lilian Thuram, éducation contre le racisme.

Un pharaon noir ?

Si vous ne le savez pas, quelle que soit la couleur de votre peau, ce livre est pour vous.

Ces portraits de femmes et d'hommes sont le fruit de mes lectures et de mes entretiens avec des spécialistes et des historiens.
