Jean-Marc Stébé, Hervé Marchal, 2019-05-15 La ville en tant qu'établissement humain s'est largement imposée dans nos manières de penser de sentir d'agir de bouger de communiquer d'aimer de consommer Il n'est donc pas étonnant de voir les grands auteurs de la sociologie intégrer la ville dans leurs réflexions Qu'il s'agisse de Karl Marx Émile Durkheim ou encore Max Weber tous ces pionniers de la sociologie ont vu dans la grande ville le lieu même de la modernité et leurs travaux

ont permis le développement de la sociologie urbaine. Si dans cet ouvrage les grandes figures Henri Lefebvre, Raymond Ledrut, Henri Raymond sont étudiés, cela ne veut pas dire pour autant que seuls les sociologues urbains sont mobilisés. Géographes, politistes, philosophes, architectes ont ponctuellement le propos au point que les limites de la sociologie urbaine deviennent parfois si poreuses qu'il semble préférable de parler plus largement d'études urbaines, urban studies. Ce manuel entend déborder le champ de la sociologie urbaine en étudiant nombre de problématiques liées au monde urbain actuel : fragmentation territoriale, gouvernance, patrimonialisation, aménagement.

A revolutionary study of nineteenth century Parisian cartography and its role in shaping a modern conception of space. Maps are rarely given the same attention as other print media or art forms in urban history. Author Min Kyung Lee shows their rich potential in this lavishly illustrated study which brings together maps and other archival materials along with drawings and paintings. She works across disciplines to examine mapping practices in the development of nineteenth century Paris and the transformative role that urban mapping had on the city's modernization. Lee investigates Paris's formation as a modern city ultimately framing the practice of cartography as a catalyst for the emergence of new spatial and compositional theories. Beginning with an examination of the emblematic urban plan that Napoleon III gave to the prefect of the Seine, Georges Eugène Haussmann in 1853, Lee explores the significance of the map itself, the means of its production through surveying, the methods of its use and reception by architects, engineers and administrators and its place in the visual culture of Paris's modernization. At the heart of this exploration is a focus on orthography in architecture and the new quality of exactitude in modern mapping practices. The precise grid structure of orthographic maps and plans evinced a sense of objectivity yet it was not without political context and social consequences as Lee demonstrates throughout.

Commerce, 1912 *Revue politique et littéraire*, 1892 Local Politics in the French Wars of Religion Mark W. Konnert, 2017-05-15

Drawing on the municipal archives of eleven French provincial towns as well as other related sources, this book explores the links between local and national politics during the Wars of Religion of the later sixteenth century. It argues that the response of the French towns to the challenge of heresy and later the Catholic League was conditioned by local circumstances. Whilst previous work has been published on the urban dimensions to the Wars of Religion, few studies provide a study of an entire province, allowing as this book does the opportunity to explicitly compare several towns. After a detailed topographical introduction placing in context the towns of the region and describing their differing urban constitutions, the following chapters deal with the crisis points of the Wars of Religion. This book sits squarely in the forefront of one of the dominant themes in the historiography of early modern France: the importance of the local community and local elites in political structures and political life. As such, it will prove fruitful reading for all scholars with an interest in early modern French urban and political culture.
