#### Introduction and Goals

Pastoral planning is the theological art of cultivating practices that structure a coherent pastoral experience for a community. Such planning questions also entail perspectives on "evaluation," in which gauges are developed for assessing the projects or procedures — the structuring — of a coherent pastoral experience. In pastoral planning, questions about the governance of Christian life and identity continually surface, and we will see that to plan pastorally with and for others is at the same time to plot one's own pastoral life.

In this course, students will gain an introduction to basic literature and questions in pastoral planning and evaluation, sharpen their thinking about what pastoral planning and evaluation are in the lives of pastoral leaders, and hone skills in planning and evaluation.
