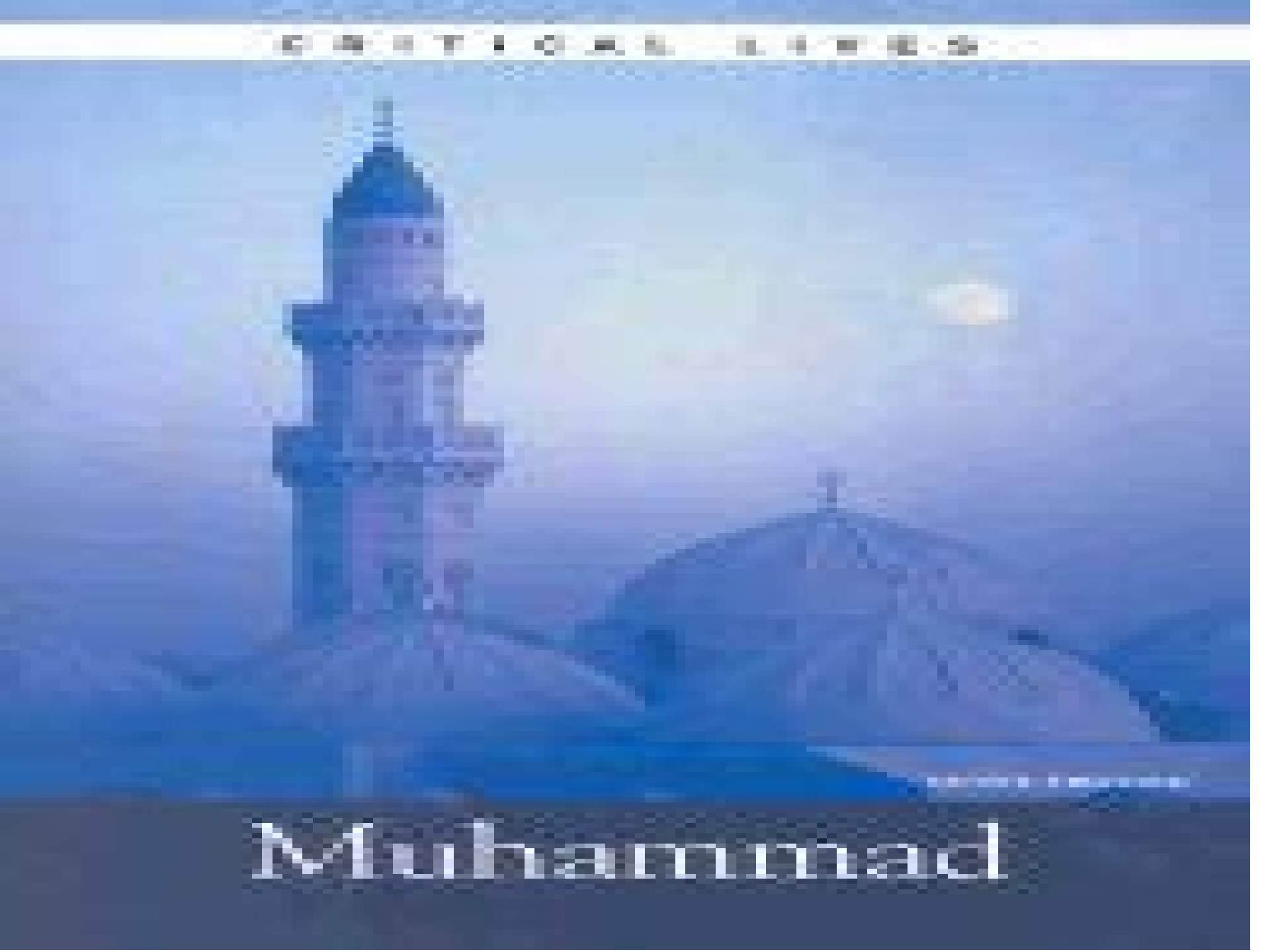
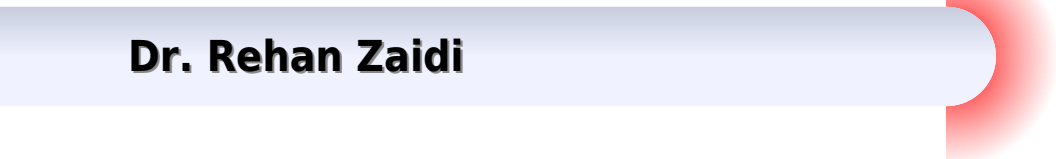

Abraham's Curse Bruce Chilton, 2008-02-19 When they arrived at the place which God had indicated to him Abraham built an altar there and arranged the wood Then he bound his son and put him on the altar on top of the wood Abraham stretched out his hand and took the knife to kill his son The Book of Genesis The story of Abraham's acceptance of God's command to sacrifice his son Isaac is one of the most disturbing of all biblical stories Isaac is spared only

at the last moment when an angel stops Abraham's hand. Theologians and scholars have wrestled with the question of why God asked Abraham to kill his beloved son, why Abraham acquiesced, and why in some interpretations he actually killed his son.
