Amitosis is a mode of Division in which nucleus elongates, constricts, in the middle and divides directly into two daughter nuclei. [Gr. a=no, mitosis=thread, osis=state]	Mitosis is a process of cell division takes place in the nucleus of a dividing cell, involves typically a series of steps resulting in the formation of two new daughter nuclei and finally dividing the cytoplasm of mother cell into two daughter cells which are identical to each other and also to the original mother cell in every respect.	The specialized cell division in which nucleus of reproductive parent cell divides twice while the chromosomes divide once resulting four daughter cells or gametes and in which the diploid number of chromosomes of parent cell is reduced to haploid in the daughter cells is called as meiosis cell division.
