Richard M. Nixon and European Integration Joseph M. Siracusa, Hang Thi Thuy Nguyen, 2018-04-13 This book re-examines the Nixon administration's attitude and approach to the European integration project. The formulation of US policy towards European integration in the Nixon presidential years 1969-1974 was conditioned by the perceived relative decline of the United States. Western European emergence and competition, the feared Communist expansionism, and US national interests. Against that backdrop, the Nixon administration saw the need to re-evaluate its policy on Western Europe and the integration process on this continent. Underpinning this study is the extensive use of newly released archival materials from the Nixon Presidential Library and Museum, the Library of Congress, and the State Department. Furthermore, the work is based on the public papers in the American Presidency Project and the materials on the topic of European integration and unification in the Archive of European Integration. Finally, the study has extensively used newspaper archives as well as the declassified online documents, memoirs, and diaries of former US officials. Mining these sources made it possible to shed new light on the complexity and dynamism of the Nixon administration's policy towards European integration. *Flight Risk* Forrest L. Marion, 2018-10-15 From the 1920s, Afghanistan maintained a small air arm that depended heavily upon outside assistance. Starting in 2005, the United States led an air advisory campaign to rebuild the Afghan Air Force (AAF). In 2007, a formal joint combined entity led by a US Air Force brigadier general began air advisor work with Afghan airmen. Between 2007 and 2011, these efforts made modest progress in terms of infrastructures, personnel, and aircraft accessions and various training courses. But by 2010, advisors increasingly viewed AAF command and control (C2) as a problem area that required significant improvement if a professional air force was to be built. In the spring of 2011, major institutional changes to AAF C2 procedures were being introduced when nine US air advisors were killed. Institutionalised Dissent Nigel Fletcher, 2023-12-22 This book provides a comprehensive analysis of a peculiar but now firmly established British institution the Official Opposition tracking its development since 1935.
