Precautions

• **Standard Precautions:** Treat all patients as if they have infectious body substances, such as blood and secretions. Practice effective hand hygiene and use barrier precautions (gloves, gowns, masks, eyewear) when caring for patients with visible blood or other body fluids.

• **Respiratory Protection:** Use appropriate respiratory protection when caring for patients with respiratory distress or when performing procedures that may generate aerosols. Use appropriate respiratory protection when caring for patients with known or suspected infectious diseases.

• **Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):** Use appropriate PPE when caring for patients with known or suspected infectious diseases.
