How to cite a journal article using APA style



To cite a journal article using APA style, you need to cover the following details of the source in the following sequence:



## SOME POINTS TO REMEMBER!

- Invert the authors' names, i.e., an author's last name should appear first followed by his/her initials, each of which must be followed by a period (.)
- If the source has only 2 authors, separate them using an ampersand (&) instead of "and"
- The **title of the article** must be followed by a period
- The **title of the journal or periodical** must be italicized and followed by a comma (,)
- The **issue number** must be followed by a comma and there should be no space between it and the **volume number**
- **Page numbers** must be followed by a period

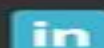
