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Manhood Acts Michael Schwalbe, 2015-11-17 In *Manhood Acts* Michael Schwalbe offers a new perspective on the social construction of manhood and its relationship to male domination. Schwalbe argues that study of masculinity has lost touch with its feminist roots and has been seduced by the politically safe notion of multiple masculinities. *Manhood Acts* delineates the practices males use to construct women and men as unequal categories. Schwalbe reclaims the radical feminist insights that gender is a field of domination not a field of play and that manhood is fundamentally about exerting or resisting control. *Manhood Acts* arrives at the conclusion that abolishing gender as a system of oppression will require more than transgressive self presentation. It will be necessary to end the exploitive economic relationships that necessitate manhood itself.

A World More Concrete N.D.B. Connolly, 2014-08-25 Many people characterize urban renewal projects and the power of eminent domain as two of the most widely despised and often racist tools for reshaping American cities in the postwar period. In *A World More Concrete* N D B Connolly uses the history of South Florida to unearth an older and far more complex story. Connolly captures nearly eighty years of political and land transactions to reveal how real estate and redevelopment created and preserved metropolitan growth and racial peace under white supremacy. Using a materialist approach he offers a long view of capitalism and the color line following much of the money that made land taking and Jim Crow segregation profitable and preferred approaches to governing cities throughout the twentieth century. *A World More Concrete* argues that black and white landlords, entrepreneurs, and even liberal community leaders used tenements and repeated land dispossession to take advantage of the poor and generate remarkable wealth. Through a political culture built on real estate, South Florida's landlords and homeowners advanced property rights and white property rights especially at the expense of more inclusive visions of equality. For black people and many of their white allies, uses of eminent domain helped to harden class and color lines. Yet for many reformers, confiscating certain kinds of real estate through eminent domain also promised to help improve housing conditions, to undermine the neighborhood influence of powerful slumlords, and to open new opportunities for suburban life for black Floridians. Concerned more with winners and losers than with heroes and villains, *A World More Concrete* offers a sober assessment of money and power in Jim Crow America. It shows how negotiations between powerful real estate interests on both sides of the color line gave racial segregation a remarkable capacity to evolve, revealing property owners' power to reshape American cities in ways that can still be seen and felt today.

The Geography of Injustice Barak Kushner, 2024-03-15 In *The Geography of Injustice* Barak Kushner argues that the war crimes tribunals in East Asia formed and cemented national divides that persist into the present day. In 1946 the Allies convened the Tokyo Trial to prosecute Japanese wartime atrocities and Japan's empire. At its conclusion, one of the judges voiced dissent, claiming that the justice found at Tokyo was only the sham employment of a legal process for the satisfaction of a thirst for revenge. War crimes tribunals, Kushner shows, allow for the history of the defeated to be heard. In contemporary

East Asia a fierce battle between memory and history has consolidated political camps across this debate The Tokyo Trial courtroom as well as the thousands of other war crimes tribunals opened in about fifty venues across Asia were legal stages where prosecution and defense curated facts and evidence to craft their story about World War Two These narratives and counter narratives form the basis of postwar memory concerning Japan s imperial aims across the region The archival record and the interpretation of court testimony together shape a competing set of histories for public consumption The Geography of Injustice offers compelling evidence that despite the passage of seven decades since the end of the war East Asia is more divided than united by history

ambition responsibility and desire Central to Taylor's argument is that Meredith's response to modern architecture and art like those of other Black cultural producers was not marginal to the modernist project instead her work reveals the tensions and inconsistencies in how American modernism has been defined In this way the book shines a necessary light on modernism's complexity while overturning perceived notions of race and gender in relation to the modernist project and challenging the notion of the white male hero of modern architecture

Sustainable Peace in Northeast Asia Yong-Shik Lee, 2023-09-05 Sustainable Peace in Northeast Asia examines the causes of lasting and complex tensions in the region from underlying political historical military and economic perspectives discusses their historical development and political economic implications for the world and explores possible solutions to build lasting peace The book is unique in that it approaches the topic from the historical perspective of each constituent country in the region Major global powers such as the United States and Russia have also closely engaged in the political and economic affairs of this region through a network of alliances diplomacy trade and investment The book also discusses the influence of these external powers over the crisis their political and economic objectives in the region their strategies and the dynamics that their engagement has created Both South Korea and North Korea have sought reunification of the Korean peninsula which will have a substantial impact on the region The book examines its justification feasibility and effects for the region The book discusses the role of Mongolia in the context of the power dynamics in Northeast Asia A relatively small country in terms of its population Mongolia has rarely been examined in this context Sustainable Peace in Northeast Asia makes a fresh assessment of its potential role

Cyclescapes of the Unequal City John G. Stehlin, 2019-10-01 A critical look at the political economy of urban bicycle infrastructure in the United States Not long ago bicycling in the city was considered a radical statement or a last resort and few cyclists braved the inhospitable streets of most American cities Today however the urban cyclist represents progress and the urban renaissance City leaders now undertake ambitious new bicycle infrastructure plans and bike share schemes to promote the environmental social and economic health of the city and its residents Cyclescapes of the Unequal City contextualizes and critically examines this new wave of bicycling in American cities exploring how bicycle infrastructure planning has become a key symbol of and site of conflict over uneven urban development John G Stehlin traces bicycling's rise in popularity as a key policy solution for American cities facing the environmental economic and social contradictions of the previous century of sprawl Using in depth case studies from San Francisco Philadelphia and Detroit he argues that the mission of bicycle advocacy has converged with and reshaped the urban growth machine around a model of livable environmentally friendly and innovation based urban capitalism While advocates envision a more sustainable city for all the deployment of bicycle infrastructure within the framework of the neoliberal city in many ways intensifies divisions along lines of race class and space Cyclescapes of the Unequal City speaks to a growing interest in bicycling as an urban economic and environmental strategy its role in the politics of gentrification and efforts to build more diverse coalitions of bicycle

advocates Grounding its analysis in both regional political economy and neighborhood based ethnography this book ultimately uses the bicycle as a lens to view major shifts in today s American city The Russian State and Russian Energy Companies, 1992-2018 Ingerid M. Opdahl,2020-06-09 The Russian State and Russian Energy Companies analyses the development of relations between the state and five major energy companies and how this shaped Russia s foreign policy in the post Soviet region The book argues that the development of Russia s political economy mattered for foreign policy over the quarter of a century from 1992 to 2018 Energy companies roles in institutional development enabled them to influence foreign policy formation and they became available as tools to implement foreign policy The extent to which it happened for each company varied with their accessibility to the Russian state Institutional development increased state capacity in a way that strengthened Russia s political regime The book shows how the combined power of several companies in the gas oil electricity and nuclear energy industry was a key feature of Russian foreign policy both in bilateral relationships and in support of Russia s regional position In this way Russia s energy resources were converted to regional influence The book contributes to our understanding of Russia s political economy and its influence on foreign policy and of the formation of policy towards post Soviet states From Head Shops to Whole Foods Joshua C.
