9-10	<u>Population Geography</u>	The student will apply social science skills to compare and contrast the distribution, growth, and characteristics of human populations by: a) examining demographic data to determine the relative level of development, including, analyzing, and synthesizing maps, charts, graphs, and pictures to determine characteristics of world regions. b) using maps and other visual images to compare and contrast historical, cultural, economic, and political perspectives. c) explaining historical cause-and-effect relationships to understand geographical connections. d) analyzing multiple contemporary sources, time and place. e) using a decision-making model to analyze and explain the limitations for and consequences of a specific choice made. f) investigating and researching to develop problem-solving and to solving. The student will apply social science skills to analyze the patterns of urban development by: a) explaining the influence of urban and rural areas on the development of world regions. b) describing the unique influence of urban areas and challenges they face. The student will apply social science skills to analyze the impact of globalization by: a) identifying factors, including transportation advances, that influence the distribution of economic activities and trade. b) describing ways the economic and social interactions change over time, and c) mapping, describing, and evaluating economic relations.
