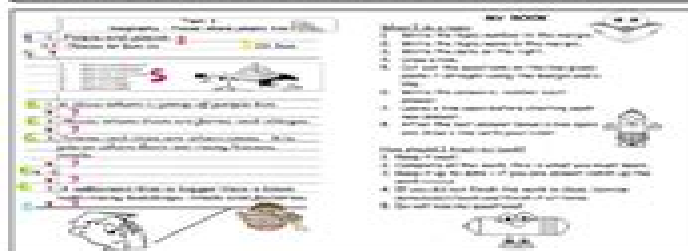


HOW TO USE THE NOTES:
