## RECONSTRUCTION

1865–1877

1. Lincoln, not just Republicans, credit war gains for postwar **Reconstruction**
2. Union soldiers take military role in former Confederacy to restore order, abolish slavery
3. **12th Amendment**, **13th Amendment**, and **Civil Rights Act of 1865** pass
4. **Radical** supporters facilitate eventual Republican control, redraw United States
5. **Steady** service of soldiers' discipline and strict **Martial Law** everywhere in the South

1863	<b>12th Amendment</b> abolishes slavery in the union <b>Robert E. Lee</b> surrenders Confederate forces to <b>Ulysses S. Grant</b> in Virginia <b>Abraham Lincoln</b> assassinated, Vice President <b>Andrew Johnson</b> becomes 13th president Union commanders develop Reconstruction plan to bring South back into Union, divide regions to keep Confederates, require states to ratify 13th Amendment Mississippi establishes system of <b>black codes</b> , limiting rights of freed blacks, creates Southern business throughout Reconstruction era 1864–65 <b>Amendment Bureau</b> established to help freed blacks find homes and jobs
1864	<b>Civil Rights Act of 1864</b> grants citizenship to all people born in the United States, grants freed slaves right to own private property, sue, serve as witnesses Congress passes <b>13th Amendment</b> to enforce constitutionality of Civil Rights Act of 1864; most Southern states reject it, and it is not ratified until 1865 White supremacist group <b>Ku Klux Klan</b> founded in Tennessee, operates throughout South by 1865
1867	Congress passes <b>Military Reconstruction Acts</b> , dividing former Confederacy into five military districts, each Southern state forced to create new government and let the constitution before applying for readmission to Union <b>Delaware</b> admitted as 37th state <b>Terms of Office Act</b> requires president to get congressional approval before removing any appointees from office United States purchases <b>Alaska</b> from Russia under direction of Secretary of State <b>William H. Seward</b> in 1867 despite purchase as "Seward's Folly"
1868	Johnson repeatedly violates <b>Terms of Office Act</b> by firing Secretary of War <b>Edwin Stanton</b> , providing weight in Congress, is <b>impeached</b> in House but acquitted in Senate <b>Ulysses S. Grant</b> elected 18th president First <b>refined</b> gold completed through high dam in California <b>Eight-hour working</b> becomes law for federal employees
1869	First <b>transcontinental railroad</b> completed at Promontory Point, Utah Samuel Pook and Jay Gould make unsuccessful attempt to corner U.S. gold market, leading to widespread <b>financial panic</b> Working grants <b>women's suffrage</b>
1870	<b>13th Amendment</b> grants voting rights for black males Grant proposes annexation of Confederate Republic, but Senate rejects Last Southern states readmitted to Congress <b>Winn-Dixie's Revue</b> of Minnie Wine becomes first black vaudeville, assuming what formerly held by white vaudeville <b>Enforcement Act</b> allows for federal intervention against Ku Klux Klan activity <b>Whitely v. Wood</b> ruling in California court establishes precedent for racial segregation in schools Carpenter Richard Henry Allen of <b>Chinese workers</b> at over one third their wages commanded by workers of European descent
1871	<b>Indian Appropriations Act</b> labels all Native Americans wards of U.S. government Anti-Chinese mob in Los Angeles results in more than 30 deaths New York Times exposed corrupt New York City police in notorious run by <b>William Henry "Boss" Tweed</b> <b>Great Chicago fire</b> caused extensive damage to city, over 300 deaths Supreme Court upholds constitutionality of federally issued paper money known as the <b>greenback</b>
1872	Grant reelected president <b>Amnesty Act</b> restores voting rights to most ex-Confederates, signals beginning of end of Reconstruction Congress establishes <b>Yellowstone National Park</b> in Wyoming as first national park
1873	<b>Slaughterhouse Cases</b> acknowledge authority of state governments over individuals, entire ruling based application of 14th Amendment to former slaves <b>Panic of 1873</b> hits United States, caused by rampant <b>railroad speculation</b> , 25% of nation's railroads shut down
1874	<b>Memphis</b> immigrants from Russia expulsions affect cottonpick in Kansas Police on horseback beat scores of unemployed demonstrators in <b>Tombstone Square Riot</b> in New York City
1875	Several of Grant's associates indicted in <b>Whiskey Ring scandal</b> <b>Civil Rights Act of 1875</b> cracks penalties for racial discrimination at work, in theaters, on public transit, in other public places, prohibits discrimination in employment, establishes right of African Americans for service on juries

1876

Federal authorities order **Sakata Sime** to reservations  
**Strong Bull** and **Grassy Horse** lead Sioux resistance to crushing defeat of Gen. George Armstrong Custer's forces at **Battle of Little Bighorn** in Montana  
**Alexander Graham Bell** invents the telephone  
**Colorado** admitted to Union as 36th state

**Rutherford B. Hayes** elected 19th president in contested race against Samuel J. Tilden; Tilden wins popular vote, but electoral count gives Hayes presidency  
Mark Twain publishes novel **The Adventures of Tom Sawyer**

1877

**Hayes-Tilden Compromise** awards Hayes presidency in exchange for removal of federal troops from Southern states, effectively ending Reconstruction  
**Marín v. Minnesota** ruling states that private industries affecting the public interest are subject to state and federal government regulation  
Whispered anti-Chinese riots take place in San Francisco

U.S. government ignores **Nav Peop** ancestral land claim in Idaho, Nevada, Nevada takes to U.S. great resentment

**Desert Land Act** gives settlers affordable land rights in exchange for irrigation

## THE GILDED AGE

1878–1900

1. Corporations and trusts begin to accumulate large capital resources, ushering in **Age of Big Business**
2. **Western** frontier rapidly closed out and populated, Native Americans forced to reservations on their redskins
3. Reconstruction policies leave **African Americans** locked in South as post-Civil War recovery continues
4. Development of cities fueled by immigration and rise of business

1878

**Timber and Stone Act** opens land in California, Oregon, Nevada, and Washington for purchase by settlers  
**Exodus** migration of black communities to Kansas to escape Democratic control of South after the end of Reconstruction  
**Blind-Albion Act** requires purchase of silver by Treasury

Woman's suffrage amendment introduced in Congress after work by Sen. **Susan B. Anthony**; Senate does not vote on it until 1884

1879

**Thomas Edison** invents the **electric light**  
White settlers begin to descend upon Native American reservations in Oklahoma, claiming for land

1880

**James Garfield** elected 20th president  
Anti-Chinese immigration **Exclusionary Army** starts work in United States

1881

Disappointed office seeker Charles Sumner assassinates **Garfield**; Vice President **Chester A. Arthur** becomes 19th president

**Booker T. Washington** becomes principal of **Tuskegee Institute** in Alabama, which provides vocational training to blacks

**Henry James** publishes novel **The Portrait of a Lady**  
Federal trademark law established to protect patentholders, encourage innovation

1882

**Chinese Exclusion Act** bans Chinese immigration for 10 years  
John D. Rockefeller forms **Standard Oil Trust**

**National Fire Alarm** established  
**Brooklyn Bridge** completed, speeding already rapid growth of New York City

Supreme Court declares **Civil Rights Act of 1875** unconstitutional  
**Maritime Pacific Railroad** between Chicago and Seattle completed

1883

**Pendleton Civil Service Act** counters patronage, reforms U.S. government's civil service practices

1884

**Grover Cleveland** elected 22nd president  
Mark Twain publishes novel **The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn**

1885

Violent anti-Chinese riots occur in Rock Springs, Wyoming, and Tacoma, Washington

1886

**Haymarket riot** occurs when Chicago police discover striking Union workers demanding 8-hour workday, 7 policemen killed, 4 persons sentenced to death, union movement's reputation suffer as a result

**American Federation of Labor (AFL)** formed to organize labor movement; **Samuel Gompers** acts as model until 1904

Chenoweth Apache leader **Geronimo** reported to Florida as prisoner of war

1887

**Webster v. Minn** ruling holds that only federal government can regulate trade between states

**Interstate Commerce Act** establishes federal commission to regulate trade between states

1888

**Quinn University Act** denies racial rights, advocates policy of forced assimilation and integration upon Native Americans, prohibits Indian land claims, forcing

Law not-fires encourage mass relocation of Midwesterners to Los Angeles

United States accounts electing first ex-Federal Harbor in Mexico's

1889

**Benjamin Harrison** elected 23rd president
