

Nouns

Nouns are a person, place, thing, or idea.

Common/Proper

Nouns are always **Common** (unspecific) or **Proper** (specific).

***Proper nouns** always begin with a capital letter!

Ex: Mrs. Carbaugh, Georgia,
Monday, County Line Elementary
School, Texas

Common Nouns: boy, girl, teacher,
cat, dog

Singular/Plural

Singular Nouns name one person,
place, thing, or animal.

Plural Nouns name more than one
person, place, thing, or animal.

*Add **-s** or **-es** to make most nouns
plural. For nouns that end in s,
consonant and y, change y to i and
add **-es**.

* Some nouns change their spelling
in the plural form and some nouns
have the same spelling.

Ex: child, children

deer, deer

Irregular Plural Nouns are nouns
that have the same spelling in
singular and the plural forms.

Abstract/Concrete

Abstract Nouns: "Unreachable"

Nouns - you **CANNOT** use your
five senses to identify these nouns!

*They can identify feelings,
concepts, experiences, ideas, and
qualities.

Ex: Beauty, love, friendship,
courage

Concrete Nouns: "reachable" nouns
- you **CAN** use your five senses to
identify these nouns!

Ex: house, book, table, phone

Nouns

Possessive Nouns

Possessive nouns tell who or what
something belongs to.

Singular possessive nouns show
ownership by one person or thing.
Add an apostrophe (') and an s to a
singular noun to show ownership.

Ex: We saw George's eggs in the nest.

Plural Possessive nouns: show
ownership by more than one person or
thing.

To show ownership, add only an
apostrophe (') if a plural noun that
ends in s.

Ex: These blue balls are made of
rags.

Pronouns

A word that takes the place of a noun.

Singular/Plural

Singular Pronoun takes the place of a
singular noun.

*Remember to always capitalize the
person's I.

Ex: I, me, he, she, him, her, and it.

Plural Pronoun takes the place of a
plural noun.

Ex: we, us, you, they, and them.

Possessive Pronoun

A possessive pronoun shows
ownership. It takes the place of a
possessive noun.

Ex: my, your, his, her, its, our, their
Deer make their home in the forest.

*The noun or pronoun that a
possessive pronoun refers to is called
its antecedent. The word Deer in the
above sentence is its antecedent.
(Deer is the possessive pronoun.)

Pronoun Antecedent

The antecedent of a pronoun is the
noun or nouns the pronoun replaces.

Ex: The stars were bright, and they
were far away.

(Stars is the antecedent of they.)

Abbreviations

An abbreviation is a short way to
write a word. Use a period after
most abbreviations.

*Remember to begin abbreviations
for proper nouns with capital letters!
Ex: Monday-Mon.

Old Street - Old St.

August - Aug.

Miss - Mr.

Pleasant Street - Pleasant St.

Commas

A comma (,) separates parts of a
sentence and helps make the
meaning clear.

- 3 or more words listed together are
called a series. In a series of 3 or
more similar words, put a comma
after each term except the last one.
The last comma should be before
and or or.

Ex: Mountains, valleys, and islands
are three natural landmarks on
Earth's surface.

- *Remember we use commas to
separate dates, and addresses! We also
use commas to help separate parts of
a sentence.

Ex: I like birds, but I hope to find
some new flowers on my trip.

Subordinate Conjunctions

(used to join compound sentences)
after, although, as, as if, as long as,
as soon as, because, before, even if,
even though, if, since, so that,
though, unless, when, whenever,
whenever, whether, while

Coordinate Conjunctions

(used to join compound sentences)
