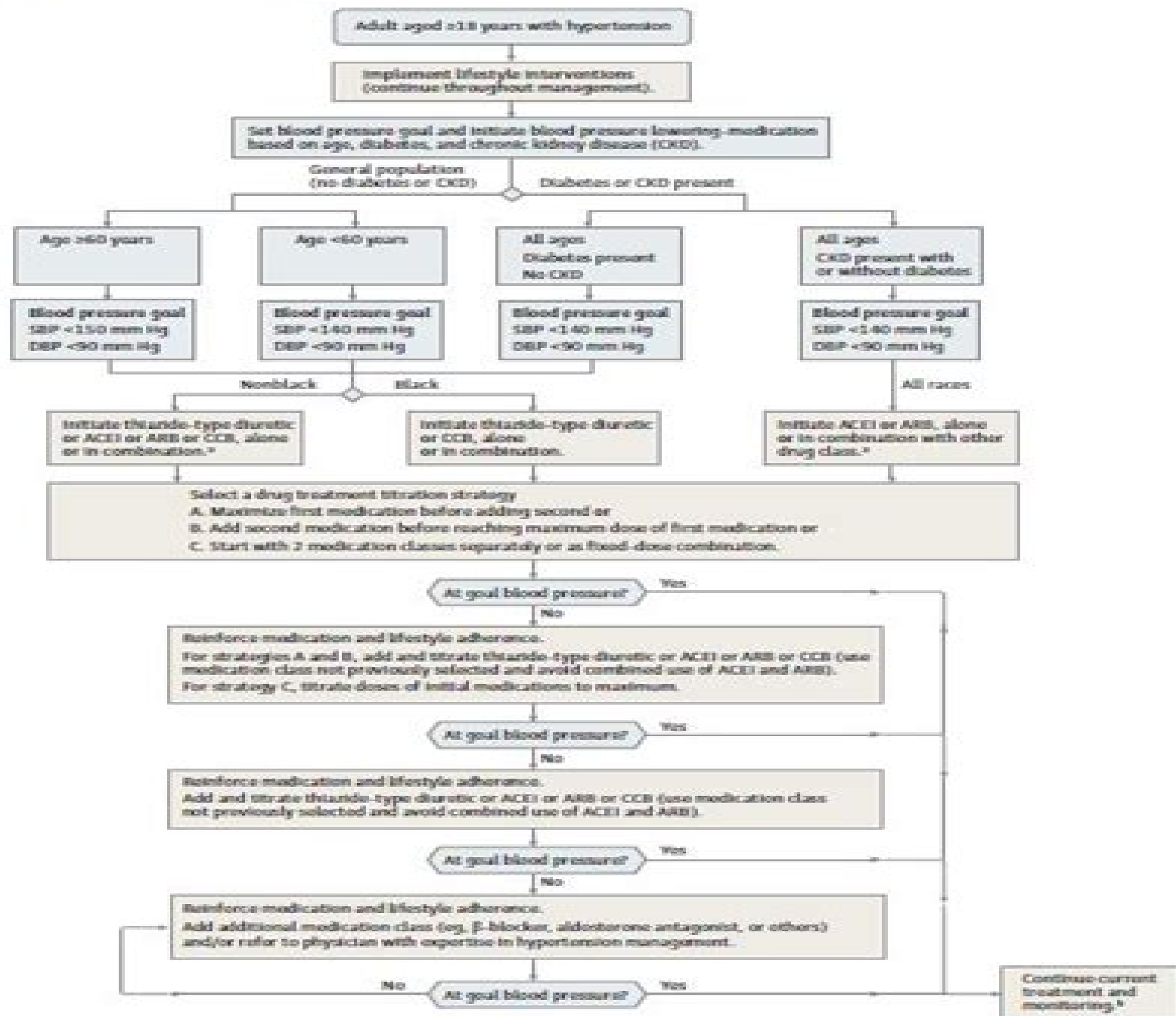


Figure. 2014 Hypertension Guideline Management Algorithm
