growth of cheating over three decades noting a disconnect between expressed shock and research that has shown over and over that most students do cheat at least some of the time Some students cheat for simple pragmatic reasons to get high grades and because they do not have time to do the work carefully However the researcher notes findings indicating that students do not generally cheat in all of their classes and that it is not the difficulty of the course that predicts in which classes they are more likely to cheat High school students especially cheat more when they perceive the teacher as less fair and caring and when their motivation in the course is more focused on grades and less on learning and understanding Students do not seem to feel that it really matters if they cheat under these circumstances Findings also suggest that students make a distinction between behaviors that are overtly dishonest such as copying the work of another which effectively serves to misrepresent one s state of knowledge and behaviors that are not inherently dishonest such as working with others which can serve to enrich one s interpersonal skills and academic learning Educators too should be cognizant of this distinction writes Stephens and be judicious in prohibiting collaboration Even with pervasive student acceptance the writer does not feel that it is acceptable as a society to tacitly accept cheating as a fact of life Cutting corners and compromising principles are habit forming They do not stop at graduation as seen in scandals in business and journalism Cheating or cutting corners in one s professional or personal life can cause real damage both to oneself and to others Stephens advocates that it is necessary both to care about and do something about cheating and that the best ways to reduce cheating are about good teaching by 1 Helping students understand the value of what they are being asked to learn by creating learning experiences that connect with their interests and have real world relevance 2 Considering whether some of the rules that are frequently broken are arbitrary or unnecessarily constraining 3 Connecting assessment integrally with learning creating assessments that are fair and meaningful representations of what students should have learned and 4 Giving students images of people who do not cut corners Finally Stephens concludes educators must strive to personally exemplify intellectual integrity looking for ways to make deep and searching honesty both palpable and attractive

of cheating behavior than other factors Part of term major and classification were significant predictors of student cheating behaviors Mastin Peska McCabe 2005 enda Duran McCabe McCabe Trevi o 1996 There has been very little research on the effect of online tools such as plagiarism tutorials and academic integrity tutorials on changing student cheating behaviors and perceptions The purpose of this quantitative study was to determine the effect of an online academic integrity tutorial on students perceptions of cheating at a large sized community college in an urban area in the Midwest Students enrolled in at least one online class participated in a survey measuring their attitudes about cheating before and after completing an online academic integrity tutorial The tests used to analyze the data to address question one included a dependent means t test an ANOVA and an independent means t test A Box Whisker Plot was created for question two and a Scatter Plot was created for question three to visually inspect the data and determine if a Pearson Correlation should be conducted Neither graphs revealed a correlation The analysis revealed that an online academic integrity tutorial had no significant effect on student perceptions of cheating However further analysis on the 29 types of cheating behaviors showed significance for five of the items The sample size was too small to successfully analyze the effect of major and age on the change in student perceptions of cheating The variable gender showed no effect but there was a significant effect between classification groups Freshmen were likely to experience a change in their perception compared to other classifications A student's knowledge of the institution's academic integrity policies did not correlate to perceptions of cheating Similarly there was no correlation between student perceptions of cheating and actual incidents of self reported cheating Nevertheless there was a positive gain in the mean scores from pre to post survey and additional research of the effect of an online academic tutorial is needed Keywords academic honesty academic integrity cheating distance education online courses plagiarism The Cheater's Handbook Bob Corbett, 1998-12-30 Exam Day Paper Due HELP I didn t study I don t test well My coach says it s OK AND I m a total loser BESIDES Everybody cheats I have A D D The teacher sucks My parents are getting divorced AND I don t need to know this stuff for real life AVOID Poor grades Flunking out Unemployment Moving back in with Mom CHEAT Higher Achievers Cheat Less? An Experiment of Self-Revealing Individual Cheating Erez Siniver, 2017 The extensive body of survey based research correlating between students cheating and their academic grade point average GPA consistently finds a significant negative relationship between cheating and the GPA The present paper reports the results of a two round experiment designed to expose student cheating at the individual level and correlate it with three intellectual achievement measures the GPA the high school matriculation average grade MAG and the psychometric exam score PES The experiment involved two classes of third year economics students incentivized by a competitive reward to answer a multiple choice trivia guiz without consulting their electronic devices While this forbiddance was deliberately overlooked in the first round providing an opportunity to cheat it was strictly enforced in the second conducted two months later in the same classes with the same guiz A comparison of subjects performance in the two rounds self revealed a considerable extent of

cheating in the first one Regressing the individual cheating levels on subjects gender and their intellectual achievement measures exhibited no significant differences in cheating between males and females However cheating of both genders was found to significantly increase with each achievement measure implying in sharp contrast with the direct question surveys that higher achievers are bigger cheaters
