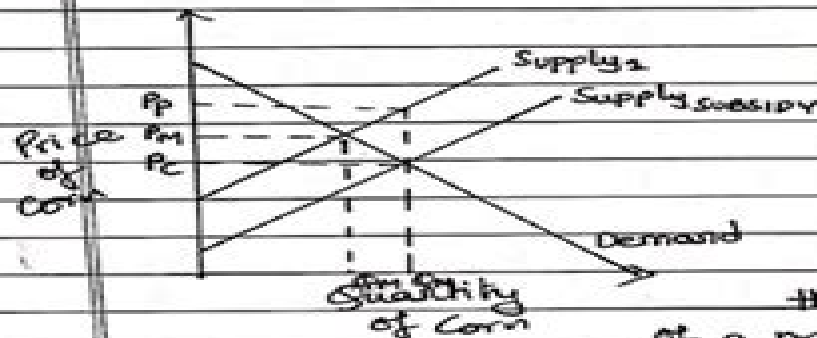


- Q.1] a) Explain why a government might introduce subsidies for food.
