International Monetary Fund, 2015-10-12 Energy prices in the GCC countries are low by international standards These low prices have co existed with rapid economic development in the region over the past 50 years but the costs of this policy have also risen in

terms of very high energy usage per capita Providing energy at low prices has also effectively absorbed resources that could otherwise have been invested in human and physical capital or saved for future generations.
