There can be no doubt that Ken Kesey's detailed, honest and scathing characterisation of Nurse Ratched and R.P. McMurphy is a criticism of society's treatment of mental illness during the 1950s. Nurse Ratched's desire for order seeks to manipulate her patients and staff in order to gain complete power. As the novel unfolds we begin to understand that she is simply the human face for society. She is part of the system that ultimately seeks to control everyone. McMurphy's unlikely Christ-like character represents salvation and freedom. Their relationship is confrontational from the beginning because they recognise the power they each have. Kesey's final message is a warning to us all about being complacent and passive in our lives. He wants to show us that we need to have courage to live our lives in spite of how difficult things may become.
