Journal 5: Write from the perspective of Peeta while he is on the Career's team. How does he feel being their ally? What did he say to convince them he would be a valuable asset?

Journal 6: Write from the perspective of Prim watching the Hunger Games live on her television. What does she feel, say, experience seeing her sister in the games.

Journal 7: Describe a time when you felt betrayed by a good friend. What happened and how did you recover from the betrayal?

Journal 8: What is the appeal of reality TV? Do you enjoy reality TV? If so, which ones and why? If not, what kinds of television shows or movies do you most enjoy and why?

Journal 9: Compare and contrast yourself with one character from the novel. Why do you see yourself most like or dislike this character?
