

To what extent was Stalin's success in the power struggle after Lenin's death due to Trotsky's errors of judgement? (25 marks)

It can be appreciated that Trotsky considerably undermined Stalin's capability to be a strong leader in the Bolshevik Party. Despite early warning signs, for example Stalin being elected to the Central Committee Party in 1917 and becoming a member of the Politburo in 1918, Trotsky viewed Stalin as a "background character" with no ambitions. But his position in the party inevitably meant that he was placed close to Lenin and was seen as a trustworthy adviser, therefore making him a major contender as Lenin's successor. This alone though was not the sole reason for Stalin's success in the power struggle, other factors such as his power base, policies and mistakes of other party members significantly contributed. So, it can be argued that Stalin would have rose to success regardless of Trotsky's misjudgement, since his integrity and tactics dominated over external influences from other party members.

Trotsky was a prominent figure in the Bolshevik party, playing a crucial role in the success of the October Revolution and the consolidation of Bolshevik power, which earned him widespread respect within the party and positioned him as one of the foremost contenders for Lenin's replacement. Yet this respect also fuelled Trotsky's self-admiration and arrogance, he was often dismissive of other party members ideas and was looked down on those he felt were less wise than him- meaning that he failed build strong alliances within the party to counter Stalin's growing influence, which left him growing authority and becoming closer to Lenin.

He was also distrusted by many colleagues due to his Jewish background and there was a fear that he would use the Red Army to seize power. Aswell as this, Trotsky had a reputation of being indecisive and failing to act swiftly- for example he was not in Moscow for Lenin's funeral which provoked accusations that he was lazy and didn't care to attend. Stalin gave the funeral oration which encouraged the idea that he had adequate leadership skills. Trotsky was delayed in asserting his claim to power, which allowed Stalin to consolidate his position as General Secretary and gain control over the party arrangement. Aswell as this, Trotsky kept silent as Kamenev and Zinoviev decided that Lenin's secret testament (first written December 1922) should not be made public knowledge. This would have been damning for Stalin's reputation (Lenin suggested he be removed from post as General Secretary) and beneficial for Trotsky's reputation as it may have mentioned that he was most capable member of his replacements. It was clear that Trotsky's mistakes left him at a disadvantage, but it is more credible to argue that Stalin's success in the power struggle was due to his own political skill. Indeed, his colleagues

From Residency to Retirement Terry Mizrahi,2021-04-16 From Residency to Retirement tells the stories of twenty American doctors over the last half century which saw a period of continuous turbulent and transformative changes to the U S health care system The cohort's

experiences are reflective of the generation of physicians who came of age as presidents Carter and Reagan began to focus on costs and benefits of health services Mizrahi observed and interviewed these physicians in six timeframes ending in 2016 Beginning with medical school in the mid 1970s these physicians reveal the myriad fluctuations and uncertainties in their professional practice working conditions collegial relationships and patient interactions In their own words they provide a view from the front lines both in academic and community settings They disclose the satisfactions and strains in coping with macro policies enacted by government and insurance companies over their career trajectory They describe their residency in internal medicine in a large southern urban medical center as a siege mentality which lessened as they began their careers in *Getting Rid of Patients* the title of Mizrahi's first book 1986 As these doctors moved on in their professional lives more of their experiences were discussed in terms of dissatisfaction with financial remuneration emotional gratification and intellectual fulfillment Such moments of career frustration however were also interspersed with moments of satisfaction at different stages of their medical careers Particularly revealing was whether they were optimistic about the future at each stage of their career and whether they would recommend a medical career to their children Mizrahi's subjects also divulge their private feelings of disillusionment and fear of failure given the malpractice epidemic and lawsuits threatened or actually brought against so many doctors Mizrahi's work covering almost fifty years provides rarely viewed insights into the lives of physicians over a professional life span

History's Daughter Maire MacSwiney Brugha, 2014-01-23 Maire MacSwiney Brugha is the only child of Terence MacSwiney one of the greatest figures in Ireland's history who died after seventy three days on hunger strike in Brixton Prison on 25 October 1920 His death became worldwide news MacSwiney is reputed to have been quoted by Mahatma Gandhi as the main inspiration for his own life's work leading to the downfall of the British empire in India Ho Chi Minh said of MacSwiney A nation which has such citizens will never surrender At the time of his death Maire was a young child Her mother Muriel a member of the wealthy Murphy distillery family had made an extraordinary and controversial match in marrying MacSwiney The young widow then abandoned Ireland for continental Europe taking her little daughter with her For nine years Maire was to live away from Ireland mostly in Germany with occasional breaks in Paris with her mother She grew up effectively as a German child speaking the German language skiing to school and forgetting all about her Irish background This was truly an extraordinary upbringing for the daughter of one of Ireland's greatest heroes In the early thirties when she was fourteen Maire made a dramatic escape with her aunt Maire MacSwiney the sister of Terence home to Ireland against her mother's wishes This was widely reported and led to a court case claiming that her aunt had kidnapped her but Maire strongly refutes this in her account here Speaking no English or Irish the young Maire now went to live in Scoil te her aunt's school in Cork For the young Maire this was a very strange world indeed Now she had to learn both Irish and English her Irish being perfected by long annual holidays in the west Kerry Gaeltacht near Dunquin And then in 1945 she married Ruairi Brugha the son of another famous republican Cathal Brugha thus uniting two of Ireland's most

prominent and revered nationalist families Throughout her life both before marriage and later with her husband M ire has handled a complex inheritance and forged her own strong identity She and her husband have reinterpreted their unique inheritance in keeping their own time and their own mindset while retaining strong links to their unusual history
